The trustees present their report with the financial statements of the charity for the year ended 31 December 2024 prepared under the receipts and payments basis.

OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES

Objectives and aims

The Charity's main objective is to provide affordable rented housing in Harton Town.

In setting their objectives the trustees have given careful consideration to the Charity commission's general guidance on public benefit.

ACHIEVEMENT AND PERFORMANCE

During the year the trustees have achieved the main aims and objectives of the charity, by providing affordable rented accommodation in the Harton Town area.

The trustees are continually spending on the maintenance and improvement of the Trust's houses to provide tenants with safe and comfortable accommodation.

FINANCIAL REVIEW

Reserves policy

At the year end, the charity cash reserves amounted to £87,329.

The Trustees reserves policy is to keep the cash reserves at between £50,000 and £100,000 to cover 2 to 3 years of normal expenditure plus any major one off repairs required to the properties. The investment asset is held as a designated reserve for improvements needed to the freehold property.

The property valuations on page 5 are out of date, but the trustees believe that there is no benefit, using charitable funds to have the valuations updated. The figures should therefore be looked at purely as a general guide to the assets held by the charity.

STRUCTURE, GOVERNANCE AND MANAGEMENT

Governing document

The charity is controlled by its governing document dated 24th August 1995, a deed of trust and constitutes an unincorporated charity.

Recruitment and appointment of new trustees

Trustees are appointed by invitation from the serving trustees.

Induction and training of new trustees

Trustees are aware of their legal obligations under charity law. In the event of a new appointment, the board of trustees are jointly responsible for briefing a new trustee on their obligations. External training may be provided if it is considered useful for the ongoing stewardship of the charity.
