We also provide a food bank facility (Paignton Community Larder) acting on referrals from various support agencies and funded by public donations and grants.

Para 1.17 and 1.19	Grants have been made to local support agencies helping the homeless and individuals. Paignton Community Larder (food bank) is now in its 5 th year. The Covid19 pandemic coupled with economic hardship has seen unprecedented demand for its services. Our purpose is to assist households experiencing food poverty and to address associated problems experienced by such households. The Charity accepts food donations, uses its funds/donations to bulk buy further food supplies, operates on a referral basis from local agencies ie Torbay Council, Age Concern etc. We also organise peer to peer support activities in a rented church hall for people experiencing mental health symptoms such as anxiety, depression and associated issues.

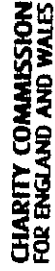
