1. Grazing Summary

9801 (near broad) – Levi has grazed this pretty extensively, as agreed, to try and reduce the rush cover. This has been reasonably effective, considering it wasn't grazed last year and the rushes were so dense when he started.

8884 (isolated reed) – the cattle have grazed a clear path through the reeds along the edge of the muckfleet, and in places further into the reedbed. This has opened up a path and the gateways into 5967

5967 (gate reed) – as with 8884, the cattle have grazed a clear pathway around the edge of the reedbed, and in some places further in. They have also opened up the gateway to 4477

4477 (easy rough) – grazing going well.

7973 – no comment as yet, this is a very! Reed dominated and isolated parcel. Levi has made great progress this year so hopefully next year we can work on this parcel.

6463 - abandoned

Grazing the remaining dryer areas as we approach the winter. Levi has asked for a derogation to graze later in the year into the new year – I have suggested we wait until November to review this with Natural England as they will not give consent sooner. Although there has been a lot of vegetative growth in the last few weeks due to the rains – so there is an increased likelihood that we will need it to put us in a good position to allow next years growth.

2. Broads Authority Summary

Brush piles between 18/13 and 18/14 will be burned – NE complained about this earlier in the year.

Scrub rouging in 18/13 will be done to open the compartment up.

Yearly cut of a 5th of compartment 18/03 will occur – strips rather than patches

Still in discussions regarding the inclusion of dyke management as part of the annual fee – this has been hampered by my maternity leave.

Fen Harvesting offered at £262.76/day – as yet we haven't

booked any work for the 22/23 winter. If Levi does a good Job grazing, hopefully we wont have to.

Vegetative report of Little Broad to be released hopefully before Christmas

3. Natural England Summary

After some crossed wires, consent stood for fencing SSSI consent.

Staithe Works – SSSI consent needs updating –

- The slubbings from the dyke were to be restricted to a short distance from the higher ground, and then following marsh level to the Broad. The extra slubbings volume was to be used near the higher ground to build up an area for cars to turn and reverse boats into the end of the staithe. My understanding from the conversations at the time of the works was that the initial slubbing work was done along the length that was slubbed to complete that phase in March ahead of the bird breeding season. The digger would then return once the slubbings had dried to pull the material back to the car turning end and restore marsh levels. This second phase of the work has not been completed and the attached plan gives the detail of what this would look like on the ground.
- Tied in with the final levelling work, the fencing and gate will then need to be installed. This was included so that access would be for permit holders only, so that use of the staithe for storing or launching boats can be regulated.
- No canoes or paddleboards are permitted, and when we have visited there have been canoes stored on site. There has been a problem with these craft on the Trinities in the last couple of years, and it may be that some of these have been stored and/or launched from the staithe.
- The trustees were to supply the Trinity warden and Natural England a list of those parishioners that had permits, but this is yet to happen. This was to be tied to those with permits and access keys once the fencing had been completed.



Deer High Seats – Dan Duthie confirmed they are facing into the arable fields and on arable land and as such shouldn't be an issue to the common.

Shooting Licence – NE have requested that we submit a bag count and supplementary feed in 2 designated areas.

Further Fencing – will need to be discussed with Levi and then consented.

Cutting – NE says we can cut the dyke banks, the BA are worried about Water Voles. Any further cutting requests will have to be applied with the BA, SSSI and HLS office.

propose permits are linked to residential dwellings rather than residents.

- Any SSSI consents for fencing will be actioned following a meeting with the grazier later in the year.

Objectives and Activities

The Charity is the result of an award of land and Common Rights set up by the Burgh and Billockby Enclosure Award 1804 and regulated under this Award for the benefit of poor inhabitants of Burgh St Margaret and Billockby. In living memory the income has mainly been distributed in the form of payments for fuel or cash payments in lieu to pensioners and widows within the parish.

The Trust is further charged with the management and conservation of Burgh Common and its adjacent land. The Trust works with a number of associates in conducting regular assessment and where necessary investment, in developing and safeguarding the SSI accreditation that Burgh Common possesses. Further opportunities exist through land sectors, which are set aside for grazing and arable farming.

Following a merger in 2010, the Charity has taken on additional activities which include the provision to each child under school leaving age who sleeps in the parish of Burgh St Margaret during the night preceding Plough Monday each year a loaf of bread on the following day.

Public benefit

The Trustees have had due regard to guidance published by the Charity Commission on public benefit and consider the Charity provides a public benefit through its distribution of fuel payments to pensioners and widows and loaves to children in the parish.

Achievements, Performance and Financial Review

The gross income for the year was £28,951 (2022: £26,099) and expenses amounted to £12,360 (2022: £21,937). Payments for loaves and cash amounted to £5,988 (2022: £6,519).

As at 31 March 2023 the charity had cash reserves of £55,625 (2022: £45,022). These reserves are held for future distribution to the beneficiaries of the charity in accordance with the objectives and activities above.

The Charity owns approximately 135 acres of wet fen, pasture and arable land (see page 2 for details). The Trustees have not obtained a valuation of this land.

On the transfer of assets from the charities stated within the trustees report, the Charity gained ownership of the following parcels of land of which the Trustees have no knowledge as to their value:

- 4.7 acres of pasture land which are let under agricultural tenancy agreements.
- Half acre of arable land (The Halfpenny Loaf Field) which is let under a short term tenancy agreement.
- 12 acres of arable and grazing land which are let under agricultural tenancies, short term leases and allotment holdings.

The charity also gained ownership of 62.11 units of income shares in the COIF Charities Investment Fund. Their value as at 31 March 2022 was £1,208 (2021: £1,111).

CURRENT LIABILITIES

Accountancy fees of £501 (2021: £480) are payable.
