The trustees present their report with the financial statements of the charity for the year ended 31 December 2024. The trustees have adopted the provisions of Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2019).

Objectives and activities

Objectives and aims

The objective of the Trust is to manage commons and grazing rights for the Freeman of Llantrisant.

In 2024, the major event was the Beating of the Bounds. There were approximately eight thousand people in Llantrisant on the day, many of whom walked the 7-mile course around the boundary of the ancient borough. The Trustees spent a great deal of time in the preparation of the event, raising funds, preparing the route and organising the day.

The everyday work of the Trust continued.

The Court Leet and following dinner took place on the eve of the Beating of the Bounds on 7th June 2024. Forty women and twenty-two men were enrolled, with large family groups being enrolled at the same time. One party coming over from America for the event.

The names on the Freeman's roll on Llantrisant.net is now up to date and will be completed with photographs soon. Application forms will be updated and available in the New Year. The next Court Leet will be held on 30th May 2025, and Arfon Haines Davies has been asked to speak at the dinner.

Many newly enrolled Freemen were not able to attend the dinner as there was insufficient capacity, and a new system will need to be introduced to enable all newly enrolled Freemen to attend the dinner on their special day.

Work on the Common is ongoing including the introduction of GPS collars for the cattle which will enable areas of grazing to be managed more effectively. This is being supported by Natural Resources Wales.

The butterfly conservation on the Common is also ongoing with new caterpillars having been put in earlier in the year.

Welsh water have been doing some remedial work on the standing water on the Common.

The land registration of the Common and Graig is still ongoing even though the Land Registry have been in receipt of the relevant documents for some time.

Measures continue to be taken to ensure the payment of Wayleave fees that have been agreed with a number of properties around the periphery of the Cymdda and advice is being sought regarding the continuing non-payment in respect of access to Rhiwgog on the Graig.

Fire breaks have been cut on the Graig.

A management plan for Castellau is being supplied by the Wildlife Trust of South and West Wales which will be completed shortly.

Finally, I would like to thank my fellow Trustees for their support during this busy year.

Financial review

Reserves policy

Restricted funds income from charitable activities amounted to £10,100. The main sources of income was from the Beating of the Bounds event.

Unrestricted Grant income received was from from National Resources Wales which consisted of the annual payment of £8,000 relating to 5 year project with Natural Resources Wales.

Unrestricted Funds other trading activities totalled £12,660 and was made up mainly of Freemen enrolment fees of £6,300 and social events and Activities £5,319

This year £527 of Bank interest was accrued in the saving account.

Expenditure amounted to £25,059 and therefore the net result for the year was an excess of receipts over payments of £7,254

Reserves brought forward amounted to £151,481 meaning reserves carried forward amount to £158,735.

Future plans

The Trust will continue to further improve Llantrisant Common.





1. Accounting policies

Basis of preparing the financial statements

The financial statements of the charity, which is a public benefit entity under FRS 102, have been prepared in accordance with the Charities SORP (FRS 102) 'Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2019)', Financial Reporting Standard 102 'The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland' and the Charities Act 2011. The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention.

Income

All income is recognised in the Statement of Financial Activities once the charity has entitlement to the funds, it is probable that the income will be received and the amount can be measured reliably.

Expenditure

Liabilities are recognised as expenditure as soon as there is a legal or constructive obligation committing the charity to that expenditure, it is probable that a transfer of economic benefits will be required in settlement and the amount of the obligation can be measured reliably. Expenditure is accounted for on an accruals basis and has been classified under headings that aggregate all cost related to the category. Where costs cannot be directly attributed to particular headings they have been allocated to activities on a basis consistent with the use of resources.

Tangible fixed assets

Depreciation is provided at the following annual rates in order to write off each asset over its estimated useful life.

The charity is exempt from tax on its charitable activities.

Fund accounting

Restricted funds can only be used for particular restricted purposes within the objects of the charity. Restrictions arise when specified by the donor or when funds are raised for particular restricted purposes.

The trustees present their report with the financial statements of the charity for the year ended 31 December 2023. The trustees have adopted the provisions of Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2019).

Objectives and activities

Objectives and aims

The objective of the Trust is to manage commons and grazing rights for the Freeman of Llantrisant.

Admission of women to the Freeman's Roll

A special meeting of freemen in 2022 resolved to admit women to the freemen's roll for the first time since 1346. The change to the constitution of the trust was approved by the Charity Commission early in 2023, and at the Court Leet on 9th June, 100 new freemen were admitted, including 77 women.

Registration of ownership of the commons

New documentation was signed by all trustees and submitted to the Land Registry by the trust's solicitor. At the time of purchase, registration of title was not compulsory, and was not carried out, but trustees decided to rectify this. At the time of writing in July 2024, the Land Registry has still not completed the registration process.

Healthy Hillides - Graig

The trust participated in a programme led by the fire service to manage the spread of bracken on the Graig in an attempt to reduce fire risk. This was consistent with the wish of trustees to promote grazing on the Graig, and was supported by Natural Resources Wales (NRW). The programme also included the chemical suppression of knotweed along the road boundary of the Graig. Vegetation clearance along footpaths was carried out by the local authority.

Management of Cymdda Common

This included the removal of willow by contractors employed by NRW, and topping of some areas of grazing. There was a fire in dry molinia grassland in the south east corner of the common that was attended by the fire service. The cattle stocking rates were in accordance with the agreement between the trust and NRW. Discussion commenced with NRW about the provision of cattle collars to facilitate fenceless grazing. A new pound was established on the western edge of Castellau Road, outside the SSSI boundary. Consent was granted for statutory operations by British Telecom and Welsh Water which resulted in minor compensation payments to the trust. Easement documentation produced by Welsh Water was challenged. Attempts to re-establish marsh fritillary butterflies were undertaken by INCC, involving the translocation of pupae raised offsite.

Land off Castellau Road

This area of about seven acres was donated to the trust the previous year. Management tasks completed included the topping of scrub vegetation on the part of the site intended for future grazing, and the seeding of this area with rhos pasture hay obtained from Pencoed College. Charitable funding was obtained to produce a management plan, and initial discussions held with the local wildlife trust to progress this.

Beating the Bounds

Initial planning for the event to be held in 2024 commenced with meetings with the police and local authority.

Unrestricted funds income amounted to £19,127. The main sources of income are from Freemen enrollment fees £10,100.

Unrestricted Grant income received from National Resources Wales of £21,680 to support the maintenance of the common. This includes an annual payment of £8,000 relating to 5 year project with Natural Resources Wales.

Restricted fund income this year amounted to £12,475. This relates to two projects, Defence Against Mining For Common Improvement and New land Maintenance. No expenditure had been incurred on this project up to 31st December 2023.

This year £115 of Bank interest was accrued in the saving account.

Expenditure amounted to £25,014 and therefore the net result for the year was an excess of receipts over payments of £28,458.

Reserves brought forward amounted to £123,023 meaning reserves carried forward amount to £151,481.

Future plans

The Trust will continue to further improve Llantrisant Common.

1. Accounting policies

Basis of preparing the financial statements

The financial statements of the charity, which is a public benefit entity under FRS 102, have been prepared in accordance with the Charities SORP (FRS 102) 'Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2019)', Financial Reporting Standard 102 'The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland' and the Charities Act 2011. The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention.

Income
