Reserves have increased in the year from £397,523 (5th April 2023) to £421,179 (5th April 2024) due to donations of £21,333. Total charitable income was £28,656 for the year ending 5th April 2024 (including interest), compared to £111,820 for the year ending 5th April 2023.
