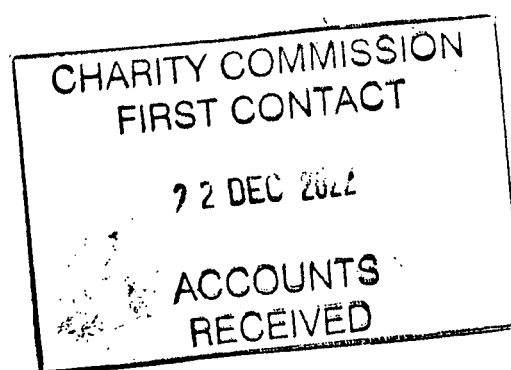

The Castlemorton Churchlands Charity is regulated by a scheme of the Charity Commission dated 28 January 1870. The registered number of the charity is 259405.

The object of the charity is to apply the income generated from the letting of pasture land towards the maintenance and repair of the fabric of the Parish Church of Castlemorton.

In the course of the year, the field known as Newland and The Sling was sold at a sealed bid auction held by R G Williams, Land Agents. The net proceeds paid to the Trust were £59,271.70. Income from a wayleave agreement with Western Power was also received.

A grant of £45,000 was made to Castlemorton Parochial Church Council for the repair and maintenance of St Gregory's Church. Additional professional fees amounted to £50.


The Statement for 2021 has been independently examined by Mr Richard George.
