Meetings The Trustees met upon two occasions during the year.

Objectives On 21st March 2024, the two Charities, Edmund Arnold's Charity and Arnold's Educational Foundation, were merged and incorporated as a Charitable Incorporated Organisation (CIO).

The objectives of the Trustees are to apply the net income of the Charity, in accordance with the new Constitution dated 21st March 2024.

Assets The main asset of the Charity is Manor Farm, Furtho, which is kept in excellent condition.

Income & Expenditure The total income for the Charity for the year ended 31st December 2024 was £69,841.19 (£67,275.36 in 2023). Administration expenses including insurance premiums amounted to £15,205.57 (£17,658.69 in 2023).

Distribution of Funds The sum of £54,635.00 is available for distribution to beneficiaries being apportioned as to £9,105.00 to the Social Care Branch and £45,530.00 to the Apprenticing and Educational Branch.

Social Care Branch During the year, grants totalling £4,347.60 (£4,322.99 in 2023) were made to individuals considered to be in need of extra comforts.

Apprenticing and Educational Branch The Trustees policy is to distribute monies credited to this branch in accordance with the new Constitution dated 21st March 2024.

During the year, a sum of £12,141.00 (£11,023.00 in 2023) was due to Merton College in the University of Oxford and grants of £16,558.99 (£11,415.00 in 2023) were paid during the year.



Social Care Branch During the year, grants totalling £5,017.99 (£500.00 in 2020) were made to individuals considered to be in need of extra comforts.

Apprenticing and Educational Branch The Trustees policy is to distribute monies credited to this branch in accordance with clause 4 of the Scheme dated 2nd November 1973.

During the year ended 31st December 2021, a sum of £7,954.00 (£8,954.00 in 2020) was due to Merton College in the University of Oxford and grants of £15,941.21 (£9,070.00 in 2020) were paid during the year.

Meetings The Trustees met upon two occasions during the year.

Distribution of Funds The sum of £40,296.00 is available for distribution to beneficiaries being apportioned as to £6,716.00 to the Social Care Branch and £33,580.00 to the Apprenticing and Educational Branch.

Social Care Branch During the year, grants totalling £500.00 (£1,612.00 in 2019) were made to individuals considered to be in need of extra comforts.

Apprenticing and Educational Branch The Trustees policy is to distribute monies credited to this branch in accordance with clause 4 of the Scheme dated 2nd November 1973.

During the year ended 31st December 2020, a sum of £8,954.00 (£9,980.00 in 2019) was due to Merton College in the University of Oxford and grants of £9,070.00 (£6,580.88 in 2019) were paid during the year.
