## **TRUSTEE RESPONSIBILITIES**

### **President:**

The President of the O.S.G.B. is the figure-head for the Society, and a well-known member of the orchid fraternity. The President is expected to promote the O.S.G.B. whenever possible; however, it is not expected that the President should attend all O.S.G.B. meetings, only those they are reasonably able to.

### **Chairperson:**

The role of the Chairperson is to lead the O.S.G.B. with integrity, vision and diplomacy, ensuring its smooth operation and strategic development and playing a key role in governance, representation and leadership. Responsibilities include:

- Acting as a visible and effective ambassador for the O.S.G.B., promoting its mission and values.
- Liaising with the President and the Management Committee to ensure the Society runs smoothly and continues to evolve.
- Representing the O.S.G.B. at British Orchid Council (BOC) meetings, either personally or by appointing a delegate.
- Chairing all O.S.G.B. Management Committee meetings, ensuring they are well-managed, inclusive and run to time.
- Attending the Annual General Meeting (AGM) of the O.S.G.B. and delivering a formal report to the membership.
- Attending all O.S.G.B. monthly meetings, chairing these meetings.
- Supporting the planning and delivery of Society events and initiatives through active engagement with committee members.

### **Secretary:**

The Secretary delivers all administrative support for the O.S.G.B., in addition to owning e-mail communication to members and non-members and the platforms related to these activities. Key responsibilities include:

- The monthly Newsletter. Procuring or writing copy for this and getting it sent via e-mail to all members. Ensuring any relevant or timely news features are shared with the Website and Social Media Secretaries for communication by these channels.
- Maintaining the member and prospect database on Wix. Ensuring that Wix is updated with current members' details and that unsubscribed members' details are removed.
- Management Committee meetings:
  - Setting up Zoom meetings
  - Circulating Agendas
  - Writing Secretary's reports and circulating all reports to Committee members
  - Taking minutes and circulating
  - Chasing and keeping track of actions



- Collating necessary reports for the AGM and Annual Supplement. Also collating nominations for Trustee and Committee posts. Taking minutes at the AGM.
- Receiving enquiries from the Website and responding either in person or by securing the information required from the most relevant Committee member.
- Maintaining an accurate and up-to-date bank of Management Committee Role Descriptions.
- Administrating the O.S.G.B.'s Google commercial e-mail accounts and drives.
- Member meetings. Setting up Zoom meetings when required and sending log-in details to all members. Hosting the member meetings on Zoom, managing the waiting room, presentations and any questions.
- The Barbara Everard Trust for Orchid Conservation. Arranging one or two meetings of the B.E.T.O.C. Trustees per year, taking and circulating the minutes. Distributing grant application forms and dealing with any B.E.T.O.C. grant requests.
- The Secretary is a signatory on the O.S.G.B. and B.E.T.O.C. bank accounts.

#### **Treasurer:**

The key responsibilities of the Treasurer are as follows:

- Liaising with the President, Chairperson and Management Committee to ensure the O.S.G.B. runs smoothly and continues to evolve.
- Attending all Management Committee meetings and submitting a report of recent financial transactions to the Committee prior to each meeting.
- Attending the AGM and delivering a formal report to the membership.
- Administering all of the O.S.G.B. and B.E.T.O.C. (Barbara Everard Trust for Orchid Conservation) bank accounts. Monies must be transferred between these accounts as appropriate, ensuring that the current accounts are always kept in credit.
- Entering all transactions into the Treasurer's Ledger, both manually and electronically.
- The Treasurer is the administrator of the O.S.G.B.'s PayPal and Worldpay accounts.
- Annually balancing the O.S.G.B. and B.E.T.O.C. books and preparing Accounts for submission to an Independent Financial Examiner (IFE).
- Writing the Annual Charities Commission Report and ensuring the Society is compliant with its charitable obligations and Trustee responsibilities. The Treasurer is the contact point for the Charities Commission and must relay information received to the other Trustees.
- Completing Gift Aid forms and submitting to the Inland Revenue.
- Carrying out the PCI DSS for Worldpay.
- Ensuring there is capability at all events to securely take payments for plants, membership, merchandise, etc. via Zettle and cash.
- Working closely with the Membership Secretary who can deputise for the Treasurer when required as only the Treasurer and Membership Secretary can hold and bank Society money.

**Membership Secretary:**

The Membership Secretary manages the membership database, subscription payments, onboarding of new members and provision of the quarterly Journal to members. This role is fundamental in the onboarding and retention of a loyal membership base. The Membership Secretary works closely with the Treasurer and carries out the following duties:

- Maintaining the membership database.
- Processing enquiries and applications for new memberships.
- Processing annual renewal payments and any resignations.
- Dispatching of Journals to members quarterly.
- Processing of credit and debit card payments.
- Maintaining a supply of cultural books, included in new members' packs.
- Maintaining and accounting for supplies of O.S.G.B. merchandise.
- Attending all Management Committee meetings, and submitting a report prior to these meetings showing the current status of membership.
- The Membership Secretary is a signatory on the O.S.G.B. and B.E.T.O.C. bank accounts.

**Displays Manager:**

The Displays Manager leads in the planning, co-ordination and execution of the O.S.G.B. displays at public exhibitions, working closely with the Displays Team to uphold the Society's standards and promote conservation and education. The key responsibilities of the Displays Manager are as follows:

- Planning and Design. Making applications to exhibition organisers and submitting designs for proposed displays. Producing budgets for proposed displays and submitting for Committee approval. Maintaining digital and hard copy records of all correspondence and documentation.
- Logistics and Materials. Organising transport and co-ordinating delivery / collection of members' plants and staging materials. Arranging supply of ferns, moss and additional orchids from trade growers or wholesale markets.
- Health and Safety compliance. Completing and submitting all required Health & Safety, Hazard and Work Method Statements by organiser deadlines. Ensuring all electrical equipment meets safety standards and certificates are available. Briefing staging personnel on, and complying with, all safety regulations.
- Team Leadership and Onsite Oversight. Working closely with the Displays Team, delegating tasks as appropriate. Selecting and co-ordinating O.S.G.B. members to stage and man the exhibits. Overseeing staging to ensure design objectives are met. Ensuring all materials and plants are returned post-show and obtaining clearance certificates if required.
- Financial Management. Keeping records of authorised and extraordinary expenditure, with receipts. Submitting claims to the O.S.G.B. Treasurer for reimbursement or arranging advance funding if needed.

**Ordinary meetings:**

The Society held ten ordinary meetings throughout the year. These were both live and virtual (Zoom) meetings. Subjects / lectures included the following:

“Spotted and Splashed Cattleyas”, a Zoom presentation by Mr. Fred Clarke of Sunset Valley Orchids, USA.

“Coelogyne”, a talk by Mr. Huw Richards.

“*Odontoglossum crispum* and its History”, a talk by Dr. Philip Seaton.

“The RHS Orchid Garden and Protect the Andes”, a talk by Mr. Thomas Cave Saunders.

“Exploring Behind the Scenes at the Mathers Foundation”, a Zoom tour by Mr. David Mathers of the Mathers Foundation’s orchid greenhouses.

“Virtual Tour at Elite Orchids”, a Zoom tour by Mr. Mark Turner from Elite Orchids.

“Adventures in Papua New Guinea”, A Zoom presentation by Mr. Kevin Stewart.

Two Auctions of orchids, where many plants are sold and purchased by members

An orchid-themed Photographic and Art Competition

At physical meetings members display their orchids, which are assessed and judged, and their history and cultivation requirements are discussed. Members have also sent photographs of their orchids in flower to the Chair of Judging and these have been judged by the O.S.G.B. judges, with the results being published on the O.S.G.B. website for all members to see.

**Shows:**

Two Open Shows were held in 2025:

“The Spring Open Show” at Squires Garden Centre, Shepperton in April; and

“The Autumn Open Show” at Wraysbury Village Hall in October

At these Shows, members compete in 40 classes for cups and rosettes.

**Library:**

The Society’s Library continued to acquire books and periodicals on orchids and orchid cultivation and to be widely used as a reference and lending library by the members of the Society.

**Displays:**

The Society built and manned three displays during the year at the following events:

“The RHS Orchid Show” at RHS Garden, Wisley in March; when a Silver medal was awarded.

“The RHS Chelsea Flower Show” in May, when a Gold medal was awarded.

“The International Orchid Show” at the BBC Gardeners’ World Live event, NEC in June, when a Platinum medal was awarded. This display was also awarded ‘Best Amateur Display’ and ‘Best Orchid Display’.

**The Journal** (and other publications):

Four issues of The Orchid Society of Great Britain Journal were published during the year. In all, this publication ran to 336 'all-colour' pages, and included articles on orchid cultivation, orchids seen in their native surroundings, members’ plants, botany and orchid pests, together with many photographs of orchids. Also included was news from orchid societies both in the UK and abroad, orchid book reviews, announcements and orchid nursery advertisements.

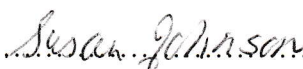

An Annual Supplement is published annually in May containing the Society’s rules and activities; this is also received by all members. **GOVERNING DOCUMENT  
and  
PURPOSE of the TRUST**

The original Governing Document of the Trust is a “Declaration of Trust”, dated 26th June 1986, made by the founding Trustees, Alexander Cedric Robert Bristow, Leslie Ernest Bowen, Timothy John Lewis, Phillip James Cribb, Peter Maudesley and John Raymond Oddy.

This “Declaration of Trust” was updated on 4<sup>th</sup> September 2021 under Section 275, part 3.4, of the Charities Act 2011 to bring its purpose into line with current views on orchid conservation. The update was carried out by the Trustees at the time; Simon Edward Alves Pugh-Jones, Amy Charlotte Malin, Sally May Mill, Pearl Jenny Thomson, Susan Johnson, Galina Boyse, Lara Jewett and David McLaughlin. The updated “Declaration of Trust” was submitted to, and accepted by, the Charity Commission and became effective in July 2022.

The purpose of the Trust is to hold on trust all subscriptions and donations made and given for the furtherance of the charitable object hereinafter contained for the purpose (if and in so far as the same shall be charitable) of conservation of all orchids by encouraging orchid growing; providing education in any form regarding orchid growing including shows, publications and supporting research; by placing endangered orchids and specialist collections of orchids with suitable collectors / collections; by supporting ex-situ conservation of orchids by seed raising and ex-situ propagation both for in-situ reintroduction and introduction into cultivation in the United Kingdom.

**REPORT of TRUST ACTIVITIES**

The Trustees have continued to invest the assets of the Trust to maximise income without incurring risk; to further the aim of setting up national collections to conserve orchids, and to promote education and conservation.

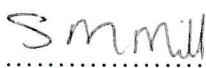
During 2025, the Trustees confirmed that they would continue their award scheme to make grants available to orchid growers holding National Plant Collections of Orchids, public orchid collections in Botanical Gardens and specialist private collections of orchids; and to schemes which aid conservation of orchids. These grants can be given for small capital projects, such as the purchase of plants, equipment or materials for the furtherance of a collection, especially for educational projects or for scientific work. The grants are awarded twice yearly (or more frequently by arrangement of the Trustees), the total amount given being up to the amount of interest accrued during the year (and carried over from previous years). Details of the scheme are publicised in the Journal of The Orchid Society of Great Britain and are also circulated to the British Orchid Council and its member societies.

In 2025, two awards were applied for, and granted:

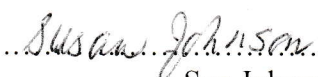
An award of £1,500 was made to the Mathers Foundation towards the cost of their seedling house project.

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**Independent examiner's report to the trustees of the Barbara Everard Trust for Orchid Conservation**

I report to the trustees on my examination of the accounts of the Barbara Everard Trust for Orchid Conservation for the year ended 31 December 2025.

“Orchids at Kew and Past Orchid Festivals”, a Zoom presentation by Mrs. Bala Kompalli from Kew Gardens

“Taiwan and the World Orchid Conference 2024”, a talk by Dr. Stuart Meeson.

At physical meetings members display their orchids, which are assessed and judged, and their history and cultivation requirements are discussed. **Displays:**

The Society built and manned four displays, three judged and one unjudged, during the year at the following events:

“The RHS Orchid Show” at RHS Lindley Hall, London in March; an unjudged display.

“The RHS Chelsea Flower Show” in May, when a Gold medal was awarded. This display was also awarded the Eric Young Orchid Trophy for the most meritorious group of orchids staged at any RHS show during 2024.

“The International Orchid Show” at the BBC Gardeners’ World Live event, NEC in June, when a Platinum medal was awarded.

“The RHS Hampton Court Palace Garden Festival” in July, when a Gold medal was awarded for a Display of Anguloas owned by OSGB member, Dr. Henry Oakeley. This display was also awarded two RHS awards; the Anthony Huxley Trophy for the best group exhibit of plants normally grown for decorative effect in a protected environment, and the Holford Medal for the best exhibit of plants and/or flowers staged by an amateur or group of amateurs at an RHS Show during 2024.

**The Journal (and other publications):**

Four issues of The Orchid Society of Great Britain Journal were published during the year. In all, this publication ran to 336 'all-colour' pages, and included articles on orchid cultivation, orchids seen in their native surroundings, members’ plants, botany and orchid pests, together with many photographs of orchids. Also included was news from orchid societies both in the UK and abroad, orchid book reviews, announcements and orchid nursery advertisements.

The O.S.G.B. Journal is received by all members of the Orchid Society of Great Britain, with new members receiving back issues where appropriate. An Annual Supplement is published annually in May containing the Society’s rules and activities; this is also received by all members. In 2013 an Anti-Fraud Policy was issued by the O.S.G.B. and in 2019 a Data Protection Policy was issued. Both of these policies are published in the Annual Supplement.

**Library:**

The Society’s Library continued to acquire books and periodicals on orchids and orchid cultivation and to be widely used as a reference and lending library by the members of the Society.

**GOVERNING DOCUMENT  
and  
PURPOSE of the TRUST**

The original Governing Document of the Trust is a “Declaration of Trust”, dated 26th June 1986, made by the founding Trustees, Alexander Cedric Robert Bristow, Leslie Ernest Bowen, Timothy John Lewis, Phillip James Cribb, Peter Maudesley and John Raymond Oddy.

This “Declaration of Trust” was updated on 4<sup>th</sup> September 2021 under Section 275, part 3.4, of the Charities Act 2011 to bring its purpose into line with current views on orchid conservation. The update was carried out by the Trustees at the time; Simon Edward Alves Pugh-Jones, Amy Charlotte Malin, Sally May Mill, Pearl Jenny Thomson, Susan Johnson, Galina Boyse, Lara Jewett and David McLaughlin. The updated “Declaration of Trust” was submitted to, and accepted by, the Charity Commission and became effective in July 2022.

The purpose of the Trust is to hold on trust all subscriptions and donations made and given for the furtherance of the charitable object hereinafter contained for the purpose (if and in so far as the same shall be charitable) of conservation of all orchids by encouraging orchid growing; providing education in any form regarding orchid growing including shows, publications and supporting research; by placing endangered orchids and specialist collections of orchids with suitable collectors / collections; by supporting ex-situ conservation of orchids by seed raising and ex-situ propagation both for in-situ reintroduction and introduction into cultivation in the United Kingdom.

**REPORT of TRUST ACTIVITIES**

The Trustees have continued to invest the assets of the Trust to maximise income without incurring risk; to further the aim of setting up national collections to conserve orchids, and to promote education and conservation.

During 2024, the Trustees confirmed that they would continue their award scheme to make grants available to orchid growers holding National Plant Collections of Orchids, public orchid collections in Botanical Gardens and specialist private collections of orchids; and to schemes which aid conservation of orchids. These grants can be given for small capital projects, such as the purchase of plants, equipment or materials for the furtherance of a collection, especially for educational projects or for scientific work. The grants are awarded twice yearly (or more frequently by arrangement of the Trustees), the total amount given being up to the amount of interest accrued during the year (and carried over from previous years). Details of the scheme are publicised in the Journal of The Orchid Society of Great Britain and are also circulated to the British Orchid Council and its member societies.

In 2024, two awards were applied for, and granted:

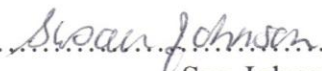
An award of £1,150 was made to the Mathers Foundation to install a misting system in their *Pleione* house.

In all, this publication ran to 336 'all-colour' pages, and included articles on orchid cultivation, orchids seen in their native surroundings, members' plants, botany and orchid pests, together with many photographs of orchids. Also included was news from orchid societies both in the UK and abroad, orchid book reviews, announcements and orchid nursery advertisements.

The O.S.G.B. Journal is received by all members of the Orchid Society of Great Britain, with new members receiving back issues where appropriate. An Annual Supplement is published annually in May containing the Society's rules and activities; this is also received by all members. In 2013 an Anti-Fraud Policy was issued by the O.S.G.B. and in 2019 a Data Protection Policy was issued. Both of these policies are published in the Annual Supplement.

The original Governing Document of the Trust is a “Declaration of Trust”, dated 26th June 1986, made by the founding Trustees, Alexander Cedric Robert Bristow, Leslie Ernest Bowen, Timothy John Lewis, Phillip James Cribb, Peter Maudesley and John Raymond Oddy.

This “Declaration of Trust” was updated on 4<sup>th</sup> September 2021 under Section 275, part 3.4, of the Charities Act 2011 to bring its purpose into line with current views on orchid conservation. The update was carried out by the Trustees at the time; Simon Edward Alves Pugh-Jones, Amy Charlotte Malin, Sally May Mill, Pearl Jenny Thomson, Susan Johnson, Galina Boyse, Lara Jewett and David McLaughlin. The updated “Declaration of Trust” was submitted to, and accepted by, the Charity Commission and became effective in July 2022.

The purpose of the Trust is to hold on trust all subscriptions and donations made and given for the furtherance of the charitable object hereinafter contained for the purpose (if and in so far as the same shall be charitable) of conservation of all orchids by encouraging orchid growing; providing education in any form regarding orchid growing including shows, publications and supporting research; by placing endangered orchids and specialist collections of orchids with suitable collectors / collections; by supporting ex-situ conservation of orchids by seed raising and ex-situ propagation both for in-situ reintroduction and introduction into cultivation in the United Kingdom.

**REPORT of TRUST ACTIVITIES**

The Trustees have continued to invest the assets of the Trust to maximise income without incurring risk; to further the aim of setting up national collections to conserve orchids, and to promote education and conservation.

During 2023, the Trustees confirmed that they would continue their award scheme to make grants available to orchid growers holding National Plant Collections of Orchids, public orchid collections in Botanical Gardens and specialist private collections of orchids; and to schemes which aid conservation of orchids. These grants can be given for small capital projects, such as the purchase of plants, equipment or materials for the furtherance of a collection, especially for educational projects or for scientific work. The grants are awarded twice yearly, (or more frequently by arrangement of the Trustees), the total amount given being up to the amount of interest accrued during the year (and carried over from previous years). Details of the scheme are publicised in the Journal of The Orchid Society of Great Britain and in The Orchid Review and will also be circulated to the British Orchid Council and its member societies.

In 2023, three awards were applied for, and granted:

An award of £1,525 was made to the Mathers Foundation to assist in the moving of a collection of *Bulbophyllum* orchids to their premises for conservation.

An award of £2,642 was made to Mr. Edward Charlton for a laminar flow cabinet to enable orchid propagation.

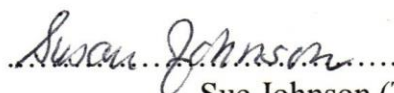

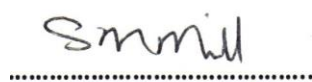

**Ordinary meetings:**

The Society held ordinary meetings throughout the year. These were both live and virtual (Zoom) meetings. Subjects / lectures included the following:

“Feeding Orchids – Feast or Famine”, a Zoom presentation by Mr. Malcolm Moodie.

“Judging Orchids according to BOC Rules”, a talk and demonstration by Mr. Michael Radley.

“Saving Orchids: their future in a warming world”, a Zoom presentation by Dr. Lawrence Zettler, Professor of Biology at Illinois College, USA.

“Orchids of the Philippines”, a Zoom presentation by Mr. Jim Cootes from Australia.

“Central America: Land of Volcanos and Forests – Ideal for Mayans and Orchids”, a talk by Mrs. Sally Mill

“The Cambridge Connection”, a talk exploring the orchid collection at Cambridge University Botanic Garden by Mr. Phil Gould and Mr. Alex Summers.

“Dracula Species”, a Zoom presentation by Mr. Trey Sanders from Orchid Botanics.

“The Large-flowered Cattleya Species”, a talk by Mr. Arthur E. Chadwick from Chadwick Orchids, USA.

A beginners’ morning with “An Introduction to Orchids” by Dr. Henry Oakeley and a talk on Phalaenopsis, followed by:

An Auction of orchids, where many plants are sold and purchased by members

An orchid-themed Photographic and Art Competition

At physical meetings members display their orchids, which are assessed and judged, and their history and cultivation requirements are discussed. Members have also sent photographs of their orchids in flower to the Chair of Judging and these have been judged by the O.S.G.B. judges, with the results being published on the O.S.G.B. website for all members to see.

**Shows:**

Two Open Shows were held in 2022:

“The Spring Open Show” at Halsey Hall, Watford in May; and

“The Autumn Open Show” at Wraysbury Village Hall in November

At these Shows, members compete in 40 classes for cups and rosettes.

**Displays:**

The Society built and manned three judged displays during the year at the following events:

“The RHS Chelsea Flower Show” in May, when a Gold medal was awarded.

“The Malvern International Orchid Show” in June, when a Silver-Gilt medal was awarded.

“The RHS Hampton Court Palace Garden Festival” in July, when a Gold medal was awarded.

**The Journal** (and other publications):

Four issues of The Orchid Society of Great Britain Journal were published during the year. In all, this publication ran to 336 'all-colour' pages, and included articles on orchid cultivation, orchids seen in their native surroundings, members' plants, botany and orchid pests, together with many photographs of orchids. Also included was news from orchid societies both in the UK and abroad, orchid book reviews, announcements and orchid nursery advertisements.

The O.S.G.B. Journal is received by all members of the Orchid Society of Great Britain, with new members receiving back issues where appropriate. An Annual Supplement is published annually in May containing the Society's rules and activities; this is also received by all members. In 2013 an Anti-Fraud Policy was issued by the O.S.G.B. and in 2019 a Data Protection Policy was issued. Both of these policies are published in the Annual Supplement.

PURPOSE of the TRUST**

The original Governing Document of the Trust is a “Declaration of Trust”, dated 26th June 1986, made by the founding Trustees, Alexander Cedric Robert Bristow, Leslie Ernest Bowen, Timothy John Lewis, Phillip James Cribb, Peter Maudesley and John Raymond Oddy.

This “Declaration of Trust” was updated on 4<sup>th</sup> September 2021 under Section 275, part 3.4, of the Charities Act 2011 to bring its purpose into line with current views on orchid conservation. The update was carried out by the current Trustees; Simon Edward Alves Pugh-Jones, Amy Charlotte Malin, Sally May Mill, Pearl Jenny Thomson, Susan Johnson, Galina Boyse, Lara Jewett and David McLaughlin. The updated “Declaration of Trust” was submitted to, and accepted by, the Charity Commission and became effective in July 2022.

The purpose of the Trust is to hold on trust all subscriptions and donations made and given for the furtherance of the charitable object hereinafter contained for the purpose (if and in so far as the same shall be charitable) of conservation of all orchids by encouraging orchid growing; providing education in any form regarding orchid growing including shows, publications and supporting research; by placing endangered orchids and specialist collections of orchids with suitable collectors / collections; by supporting ex-situ conservation of orchids by seed raising and ex-situ propagation both for in-situ reintroduction and introduction into cultivation in the United Kingdom.

**REPORT of TRUST ACTIVITIES**

The Trustees have continued to invest the assets of the Trust to maximise income without incurring risk; to further the aim of setting up national collections to conserve orchids, and to promote education and conservation.

During 2022, the Trustees confirmed that they would continue their award scheme to make grants available to orchid growers holding National Plant Collections of Orchids, public orchid collections in Botanical Gardens and specialist private collections of orchids; and to schemes which aid conservation of orchids. These grants can be given for small capital projects, such as the purchase of plants, equipment or materials for the furtherance of a collection, especially for educational projects or for scientific work. The grants are awarded twice yearly (or more frequently by arrangement of the Trustees), the total amount given being up to the amount of interest accrued during the year (and carried over from previous years). Details of the scheme are publicised in the Journal of The Orchid Society of Great Britain and in The Orchid Review and will also be circulated to the British Orchid Council and its member societies.

In 2022, just one award was applied for, and granted. A conservation award of £673 was made to the Mathers Foundation to assist in the conservation of a collection of *Stanhopea* orchids.

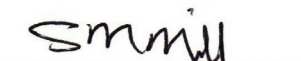

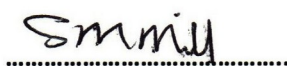

At this Show members competed in 40 classes for cups and rosettes.

**Displays:**

The Society built and manned two judged displays during the year at the following events:

“The RHS Hampton Court Palace Garden Festival” in July when a Gold medal was awarded. This display was also awarded The Eric Young Orchid Trophy for 2021 by the RHS, for the most meritorious group of orchids staged at any RHS show.

“The RHS Chelsea Flower Show” in September when a Silver-Gilt medal was awarded.

**Library:**

The Society’s Library continued to acquire books and periodicals on orchids and orchid cultivation and to be widely used as a reference and lending library by the members of the Society.

**The Journal (and other publications):**

Four issues of The Orchid Society of Great Britain Journal were published during the year. In all, this publication ran to 336 'all-colour' pages, and included articles on orchid cultivation, orchids seen in their native surroundings, members’ plants, botany and orchid pests, together with many photographs of orchids. Also included was news from orchid societies both in the UK and abroad, orchid book reviews, announcements and orchid nursery advertisements.

The O.S.G.B. Journal is received by all members of the Orchid Society of Great Britain, with new members receiving back issues where appropriate. An Annual Supplement is published annually in May containing the Society’s rules and activities; this is also received by all members. The original Governing Document of the Trust is a “Declaration of Trust”, dated 26th June 1986, made by the founding Trustees, Alexander Cedric Robert Bristow, Leslie Ernest Bowen, Timothy John Lewis, Phillip James Cribb, Peter Maudesley and John Raymond Oddy.

This “Declaration of Trust” was updated on 4<sup>th</sup> September 2021 under Section 275, part 3.4, of the Charities Act 2011 to bring its purpose into line with current views on orchid conservation. The update was carried out by the current Trustees; Simon Edward Alves Pugh-Jones, Amy Charlotte Malin, Sally May Mill, Pearl Jenny Thomson, Susan Johnson, Galina Boyse, Lara Jewett and David McLaughlin. The updated “Declaration of Trust” has been submitted to, and accepted by, the Charity Commission and will become effective in July 2022.

The purpose of the Trust is to hold on trust all subscriptions and donations made and given for the furtherance of the charitable object hereinafter contained for the purpose (if and in so far as the same shall be charitable) of conservation of all orchids by encouraging orchid growing; providing education in any form regarding orchid growing including shows, publications and supporting research; by placing endangered orchids and specialist collections of orchids with suitable collectors / collections; by supporting ex-situ conservation of orchids by seed raising and ex-situ propagation both for in-situ reintroduction and introduction into cultivation in the United Kingdom.

**REPORT of TRUST ACTIVITIES**

The Trustees have continued to invest the assets of the Trust to maximise income without incurring risk; to further the aim of setting up national collections to conserve orchids, and to promote education and conservation.

During 2021, the Trustees confirmed that they would continue their award scheme to make grants available to orchid growers holding National Plant Collections of Orchids, public orchid collections in Botanical Gardens and specialist private collections of orchids; and to schemes which aid conservation of orchids. These grants can be given for small capital projects, such as the purchase of plants, equipment or materials for the furtherance of a collection, especially for educational projects or for scientific work. The grants are awarded twice yearly (or more frequently by arrangement of the Trustees), the total amount given being up to the amount of interest accrued during the year (and carried over from previous years). Details of the scheme are publicised in the Journal of The Orchid Society of Great Britain and in The Orchid Review and will also be circulated to the British Orchid Council and its member societies.

In 2021, just one award was applied for, and granted. An award of £3,000 was made to the Orchid Society of Great Britain (O.S.G.B.) to assist with an educational display of orchids at the RHS Chelsea Flower Show in September.
