The Charity made donations totalling £60,000 to sixteen charitable institutions supporting Christian communities and organisations. The largest donation (£25,000) was given to Holy Rood House, a charity with a Christian ethos whose objectives are to provide safe spaces and support for those who are finding life difficult and challenging. A further £15,000 was given to The Bible Society, which works to bring The Bible to people across the world who might not otherwise have access.





