2023 TRUSTEES' REPORT

Another year has passed so quickly with little change to running the bungalow except it is getting busier and taking a lot more time to keep on top of everything. It is lovely to see the bungalow coming back to the way it was before Covid and the coffee shop busy and looking so much smarter.

First may we mention one of our long-standing trustees and volunteers who sadly passed away in Autumn 2023, Sylvia Lyons, who was always ready to help, get involved and for us a wonderful source of knowledge about the Friends charity and she is sadly missed by us all.

In addition, another long-standing trustee and volunteer, June Vinton, also passed away earlier in 2024.

We have raised concerns about the running cost of the bungalow, membership numbers and getting volunteers and, to be honest, nothing has changed. The Cornwall Foundation Trust (CFT) has not moved forward with leasing the bungalow but they are now picking up all the maintenance costs around the bungalow and all the relevant NHS statutory regulation checks that need to be done every month and yearly. The CFT office staff are helpful and friendly when contacted and their engineers come in a timely manner to put any faults right which is saving the charity a lot of money. We still do not charge the NHS for clinics which was the idea when the bungalow was first bought to provide services for patients but the trustees are reviewing this all the time. Fundraising is not raising enough to cover all the costs.

If it was not for the very hard working volunteers the Friends could not continue to do what they do for the hospital.

We have been working hard to get more clinics in the bungalow so it is easier for patients not having to travel to other hospitals and paying parking and travel costs.

From the attached accounts it is noted that we received substantial legacies from the estates of Valerie Head (£28,258.03) and Dennis Yelland (£134,194.39). Of the £28,258.03, £8,258.03 is shown within the sundry donations total of £9,413.33.
