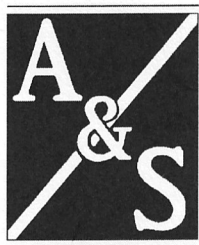

STRUCTURE, GOVERNANCE AND MANAGEMENT

The League of Friends of Minehead and West Somerset Hospital and the Community is subject to a Constitution dated 24 March 1971, amended 25 October 1978, amended 25 August 2021 and currently under review.

Under the Constitution the committee shall consist of the Treasurer and the Secretary (appointed by the Committee), and not less than 7, nor more than 12, other persons. One third of the committee members retire each year, but may be re-elected immediately. The Chairman is elected by the Committee to serve for a period of up to two years, and is not subject to retirement by rotation. Members shall pay an annual subscription payable on 1 April each year.

Since March 2021 The League of Friends for Minehead Hospital and the Community was not quorate having only six voting members instead of seven as stated in the Constitution. The committee actively sought new members despite the Covid-19 restrictions and at the next face to face meeting due to be held on the 21st July 2021 they voted in two new people, Alan Helmsley who agreed to be Secretary and Mary Butcher. These appointments meant the committee was back to having eight members/ trustees who were able to vote.

Requests for assistance are made by Minehead Community Hospital and are referred to the full committee. Tenders are obtained prior to purchase of high value items, in order to obtain best value.

OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES

The object of the Charity is to relieve all patients and former patients of Minehead and West Somerset Hospital and other patients in the community who are sick, convalescent, disabled, handicapped, infirm or in need of financial assistance and, generally, to support the charitable work of the hospital. The Charity provides a focus for financial assistance to be channelled to the Hospital and raises funds to assist patient comfort and help maintain the facilities offered by the Hospital. The trustees have had regard to the Charity Commission guidance on public benefit.

ACHIEVEMENTS AND PERFORMANCE

During the year to 30 September 2021 the Charity was in receipt of donations totalling £513 and subscriptions and collections totalling £901. Bank interest received amounted to £12.

The Charity also received legacies of £43,845.

Funds of £9,318 were used towards the cost of medical equipment for the Minehead Community Hospital. The equivalent total expenditure on medical equipment for the previous year was £15,874.

The income and expenditure account for the year shows an excess of income over expenditure of £35,777 (2020: excess of expenditure over income of £13,558). The Statement of Assets and Liabilities at the year end shows funds held totalling £336,162 (2020: £300,385).

RESERVES

Reserves are used when requests for assistance are made by the hospital, and the Charity has no policy requiring a minimum balance to be maintained. Funds surplus to immediate requirements are held on account. The accounts are reviewed regularly by the Treasurer to ensure the best interest rates are obtained.

During the year the reserves of the Charity increased by £35,777 to £336,162. Substantial funding was given towards facilities and equipment for the hospital over the previous years.

STATEMENT OF COMMITTEE MEMBERS' RESPONSIBILITIES

The Members of the Committee are responsible for keeping accounting records which are such as to disclose with reasonable accuracy, the financial position of the Charity at any time, and to enable them as Committee Members to ensure that the financial statements comply with the charity law and the Charity's Constitution. They are also responsible for safeguarding the Charity's assets, and hence for taking reasonable steps for the prevention and detection of fraud and other irregularities.

PUBLIC BENEFIT

The Members of the Committee confirm that they have complied with the requirements of section 17 of the Charities Act 2011 to have due regard to the public benefit guidance published by the Charity Commission for England and Wales.

I report on the accounts of the charity for the year ended 30 September 2021, which are set out on pages 5 to 6.

Respective responsibilities of trustees and examiner

The trustees are responsible for the preparation of the accounts. The trustees consider that an audit is not required for this year under section 144(2) of the Charities Act 2011 (the 2011 Act) and that an independent examination is needed.

- examine the accounts under section 145 of the 2011 Act;

Basis of independent examiner's report
