Summary of the purposes of the charity as set out in its governing document	The objects of the charity are the furtherance and promotion of the Jewish religion and Jewish religious education in any part of the world, and to assist Neve Yerushalayim Seminary, Israel primarily by raising funds and enlisting support and assistance.

The funds raised by the charity have allowed the Neve Yerushalayim Seminary to continue its mission; "to educate, inspire, and empower young women, ages 18-33, who have little or no knowledge of Jewish heritage". Since 1970 more than 35,000 women from all over the world have attended Neve. Located on six acres on one of the highest points in Jerusalem, the picturesque campus provides a safe and nurturing environment for women to explore and find meaning in their Jewish identity.

Review of the charity's financial position at the end of the period	At the year end, the charity held £13,277 in unrestricted reserves. These funds are due to be donated to the Neve Yerushalayim Seminary, net of any administrative expenses incurred.
Statement explaining the policy for holding reserves stating why they are held	The trustees have decided that there is no need for the charity to hold significant reserves, as grants are only made if there are available reserves, and there are no ongoing material overhead or administrative costs.

Description of charity's trusts:	The charity is constituted and governed by a Trust Deed dated 20 June 1973. The charity is managed and controlled by the trustees, who meet regularly.
