Dungeness Bird Observatory Trust is based on the peninsula at Dungeness, Kent and has nine trustees who meet at least three times a year to discuss the past and look to the future in order to manage the charity. New trustees are chosen from those with an interest in the observatory and of the recording of birds in the area. Generally new trustees will be known by at least some of the current trustees and are required to be Friends of the Observatory.

The objectives of the charity remain the same. They are to record details of the bird and other wildlife of the area including the migration of all wildlife.

Daily records were kept for birds, mammals and some invertebrate groups, particularly Lepidoptera, Odonata, Orthoptera, Hemiptera and Hymenoptera. The plant list was also maintained. Bird ringing was carried out whenever the opportunity arose but only 510 birds of 40 species were ringed. This, sadly, reflects the continuing decline in numbers of migrant passerines over the past few years and the increasing number of days when the weather is either too wet or too windy for mist-netting. Nocturnal migration of birds (Nocmig) was also studied using an Audiomoth device.

The Motus Tower, installed in 2019, had a number of interesting "hits" from small migrant birds this year including Skylark, Blackcap and Yellow-browed Warbler plus Nathusius' Pippistrelle, a small, migratory bat species. The Motus system is an international, collaborative research network using co-ordinated, automated radio telemetry to facilitate research and education on the ecology and conservation of migratory animals.

The benefit to all of seeing the wildlife in the area is not only educational but good for our mental well-being. The trustees and warden do all they can to liaise well with those using the area, residents and visitors alike.

Accommodation at the Observatory was occupied for approximately 130 visitor/nights, a low figure but, again reflective of changing times but, this time, in the behaviour of birders themselves!

Full details of the finances are included in the annual report but we received income of £41,700 which included £32,300 of income from investments and expended £40,600 leaving a surplus of £1,100 before the movement in value of investments. The Balance Sheet total funds had risen to £1.196m primarily as a result of the increase in the value of our investments.
