MAJOR ACTIVITIES AND ACHIEVEMENTS IN THE YEAR

The Group remains in a healthy state but due to a reduction of leaders is operating with one less pack.

The year to 31 March 2022 saw a recovery of activity with packs now back to face to face meetings each week and starting to get involved in more activities.


Nurseries were still able to operate for all of the year, so we are now back to normal levels of rental income from Saplings, following the reduce rental last year due to covid related lockdowns.

We did successfully apply for a grant from the St Albans Council for £8,000 which has helped to ensure we have not financially suffered due to COVID and associated restrictions.

The Group is a trust established under its rules which are common to all Groups
