This is a postal account, with the last statement being sent to a former Trustee. The former Trustee has confirmed that no further statements have been received and subsequently contacted NS&I in October 2024 to notify them of a change in Trustees and to request an updated statement. At the time of writing this report, the statement has still to be issued. I can advise that the current Treasurer has made a further written request to NS&I to resolve the matter. As a result, I am therefore currently unable to verify the Investment Account balance as at 31 August 2024.
