Legal, Administration and Membership

Henry Tyndale School Association is a registered charity (No.274092) and is governed by a written constitution (as amended at a special meeting held on 26th February 1998). The Association's name was changed from The Grange School (Aldershot) Association at a Special General Meeting held on 15th June 1998. The Association's address is Ship Lane, Farnborough, Hampshire, GU14 8BX.

The Association is administered by a Management Committee. The members of the committee who acted during the year are listed on page 1.

Membership of the Association is open to the parents of all children attending Henry Tyndale School and all members of the school's staff, together with anyone who has a continuing interest in the school and who is proposed and accepted for membership.

Objectives of the Association

The association is non-political and is a member of the National Confederation of Parent Teacher Associations. The objectives of the Association are to advance the education of the pupils at Henry Tyndale School by the provision of facilities for education at the school (not normally provided by the local education authority). It also aims to foster more extended relationships between the school's staff, parents and others associated with the school and to engage in activities that support the school and advance the education of the pupils attending it.

Review of charitable activities for the year

The Association's receipts and payments for the year are disclosed in the annexed accounts that show the donations received and fund raising activities during the year together with expenditure incurred on the continued support of Henry Tyndale School.

After the impact of Covid on our Charity events, this year has been a year of consolidation. There are School projects in the pipeline, the Sensory room is top of the requirement list, so the PTA have used the year to fund raise and increase the balances in all bank accounts

We receive many donations throughout the year and the PTA would like to thank everyone involved with fundraising activities in whatever capacity they have contributed.

The bank and cash balances held by the Association at 31st July 2022 amounted to £79,971.96 (2021: £45,315.95).
