All members of the Executive Committee retire at the end of the general meeting next after the date on which they came into office, but they may be re-elected or reappointed.

Trustees are recruited from the membership as required.

Activities and Objectives

The objects of the Society shall be to educate the public in the arts and sciences, and in particular the art and science of music; and in furtherance of this objective but not otherwise, to establish the rehearsal and performance of choral music.

The Trustees have had regard to the guidance issued by the Charity Commission on public benefit.

During the year the Society performed three concerts open to the public, for the benefit of the cultural life of the town and audience appreciation, as well as to the benefit of the Society's members.

Financial Review

The attached accounts show that the finances of the Society are currently healthy. The reserves of £24,517 are sufficient to enable the Society to continue for at least 6 months regardless of income received. This complies with the reserves policy. The Trustees and Executive Committee continuously monitor choir and audience numbers with regard to the ability of the Society to continue as a going concern.
