## Trustees' Annual Report

### About the charity

The Ravenscote PTA charity (Charity number: 277432) was founded with the aim of supporting the work of Ravenscote Junior School. We make their tight budget a bit less tight. During an academic year we organise several fundraising events, which on top of raising money also creates memories to cherish for a lifetime for the pupils of the school.

### What was done

In the September 2023 – August 2024 period the charity had the following fundraising events:

- 2 discos, which resulted in £4,506 profit
- Our biggest event every year is the fireworks in November. It is big community event and this year we generated £12,729 profit with this night
- Outdoor Cinema – this was a new take on the usual summer fair. Instead of a traditional fair we organised a cinema night, which was hugely enjoyable, but due to the high cost of the screening it did not make any profit
- To promote sustainability, we run a second-hand uniform shop and raise money by collecting unwanted, good quality clothing. These raised £674 for the charity.

### What was achieved

In this academic year, we were in the position of being able to support our junior school through grants. We were able to say yes to the following requests:

- The running cost of the minivan – which was purchased by the PTA in an earlier period (£2,710)
- Improving the outdoor classroom (£2,450)
- Replacing the computers in the IPC Suite (£15,000)
- Equipment for science and design & technology subjects (£4,145)

When we make the decision about a request, we always make sure the whole of the school benefit from it, not just a specific group of children.


