The Trustees present their report and financial statement for the year ended 31st March 2025.

The organisation is an unincorporated charity established by a Trust Deed dated 16th May 1980 and amended by a Deed dated 31st December 2016 and both registered with the Charity Commission.

Trustees

Under the terms of the Trust Deeds there must be at least three and not more than ten Trustees. The appointment of new Trustees is vested in the existing Trustees. All the existing Trustees are familiar with the Charity's work having served for some time. New Trustees are educated in the Charity's workings and their responsibilities by the existing Trustees.

Investment

Under the terms of the Trust Deed, the Trustees have the power to make any investment they see fit.

Management

The Trustees are directly involved in all management aspects of the organisation.

Risk Management

The Trustees have conducted a review of the major risks to which the Charity is exposed. A risk register has been established and will be updated annually.

Objectives and activities

The main aim of the Trust is the advancement of education of young people by helping them to develop their mental and spiritual capacities through leisure time activities, particularly in the tradition of the Brady Clubs and Settlement, and to document the heritage of the Clubs and its exemplar of the benefits of Youth Clubs.

Financial review

Statement of Trustees' responsibilities

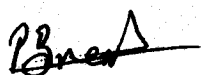

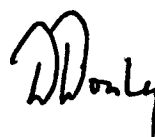
- Select suitable accounting policies and apply them consistently.

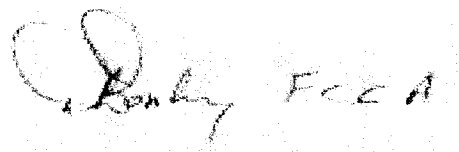

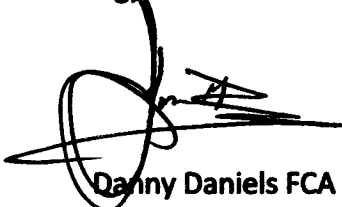
Independent examiner's statement
