Structure, Governance and Management

The name of the charity is Tzedokah Trust and it is governed by a trust deed. The charity is registered with the Charity Commission under number 281478. The trustees, who meet at regular intervals, administer the charity and manage the day to day operations.

Objectives and Activities

The principal activity and objectives of the charity are to advance the Orthodox Jewish faith and the relief of poverty by raising funds and making donations to charities which promote Jewish teaching and study and relief of poverty.

Achievements and Performance

The achievements were to raise money by soliciting donations to the amount stated in the accounts and making grants to various charitable institutions involved in Jewish education and relief of poverty.

Financial Report

During the year donations and gift aid tax repayments received amounted to £29,655 (£22,273 - 2023). Grants to charities were £31,663 (£29,577- 2023). Income for the following and future years is expected about the same and reserves have been retained to allow the charity to continue supporting various charitable causes in the future.

to keep accounting records in accordance with section 41 of the 1993 Act;

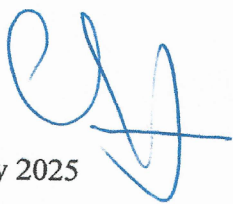

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities and the charities SORP.

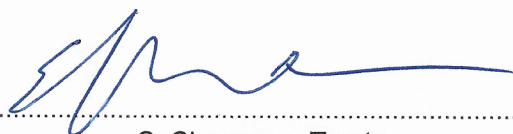
(c) Incoming Resources
