These centres provide a community focus for the education and assimilation of all children, regardless of their background and origins, by the availability of sports and educational programmes.

The Charity’s trustees are as follows: Ilan Allali, Eyal Taoz, Lilo Tzarfati, Paul Goldstein and James Robert Collins.

The Charity’s sole purpose is to fundraise in the UK for the benefit of the Israel Tennis & Education Centers Foundation; Paul Goldstein and James Robert Collins serve as volunteer trustees (ie, they receive no remuneration from the Charity), and Ilan Allali, Eyal Taoz and Lilo Tzarfati are employees of the Israel Tennis & Education Centers Foundation, but receive no remuneration from the Charity.

The Charity does not have any activities other than a handful of fundraiser events each year, and its sole objective is to fundraise in order to support the Israel Tennis & Education Centers Foundation. The Israel Tennis & Education Centers Foundation has a long tradition to engage and integrate children and youth from different cross-sections of Israeli society (e.g., of different socio-economic backgrounds, and different ethnicities (e.g., Jews (including Ethiopians) and Arabs (Muslim and Christian)).

In 2024 the Charity successfully managed to fundraise in excess of GBP 50,000, supporting its activities and objectives in the year. The Charity has no debt.
