## TRUSTEES' ANNUAL REPORT

---

The Trustees submit their report and the financial statements of the Friends of Dorset Opera for the year to 30<sup>th</sup> September 2022.

### STATUS AND OBJECTIVES

The Friends of Dorset Opera ("the Friends") is a registered charity (No 284784) established by a Trust Deed dated 14<sup>th</sup> April 1982. Its objective is to raise funds by public subscription to be paid by way of annual grant to Dorset Opera Festival (registered charity No 1105318).

The Friends' registered address is Willow Barn, Stalbridge Weston, Sturminster Newton DT10 2LA.

### REVIEW OF ACTIVITIES

The Friends continued to support Dorset Opera Festival. The 2020 festival having had to be cancelled in view of the Covid-19 pandemic, the Trustees carried forward a substantial sum from that year, enabling them to make a grant of £35,000 in support of the 2022 Festival's productions of Mozart's *Die Zauberflöte* and Puccini's *Manon Lescaut*.

### PUBLIC BENEFIT

The Friends provide public benefit by supporting Dorset Opera Festival, which itself benefits the public.

### INVESTMENT POWERS, POLICY AND PERFORMANCE

The Trustees have the power to invest the money of the Charity not immediately required for its purposes in such investments or property as they think fit. Currently cash reserves are held in a low risk deposit account which gives immediate access to these funds.

### RESERVES POLICY

The charity works closely with Dorset Opera Festival and may, as required, build up a level of reserves to help meet any longer term productions undertaken by the Festival. A small level of cash reserves is normally maintained to cover unforeseen circumstances.

As the charity trustees of the Trust you are responsible for the preparation of the accounts in accordance with the requirements of the Charities Act 2011 ('the Act').


