Friends of St Peter's Church - Annual Report for 2020

Background: The Friends of St Peter's Church, Ropley was formed in 1982. The objects of the Association are the preservation, repair, restoration, improvement and ornamentation of the fabric of St. Peter's Church and to provide articles for use in worship there. The Friends can also assist in the upkeep and improvement of the Ropley Coffee Room. The Friends promote interest in the Church for the wider benefit of the Community and its heritage and raise funds by way of subscription, donation and through fund raising to further its objectives. The church was virtually destroyed by fire in June 2014 and services are now held in Ropley Parish Hall pending restoration of the church.

Review of the year

Following the fire in 2014 the focus for the Friends continues to be to co-operate with the PCC on the proposals for the restoration and refurbishment of St Peter's Church and have committed the existing funds and future fundraising towards any shortfall above the insurance cover. The Friends also support the Development Group which was formed to assist the PCC in raising funds for the church appeal fund.

The Committee met on five occasions during the year and as necessary on other occasions relating to fundraising activities. The Churchwardens continue to keep the Friends informed on all church matters particularly relating to the restoration of the Church and update regularly on the progress since the fire.

Membership of the Friends continues to increase slowly. At the year-end the total of individual or family members was 58 with an overall total membership of 93.

Fund raising activities

Subscription income for the year was £2,827. This, together with tax reclaimed from 2019/2020 Gift Aid subscriptions (£648) gave a total of £3,475, subscription income being slightly higher than last year. In addition donations towards Ropley Church Appeal totalled £35,046 which together with Gift Aid recovered of £1,334, Easy Fundraising of £300 and sale of Christmas Cards £759 added £37,439 for the appeal. There was only one fund raising event during the year and together with the sale of cooking apron raised a total of £940.

Financial Review

Total income in 2020 was £41,995, less expenses of £154 there was a surplus for the year of £41,841 but a further grant of £65,000 was made to the PCC Appeal Fund leaving the total bank assets and investments at the year-end of £32,458.

Since the Friends were formed in 1982 total income over the last 39 years has been £279,504 with total expenditure of £247,058 of which £244,066 (99%) was given for the Church and Coffee Room, the remaining £2,992 (1%) was in respect of fundraising and administration expenses, an average of £76 per year.

As the charity's trustees you are responsible for the preparation of the accounts in accordance with the requirements of the Charities Act 2011 ('the Act').


