FRIENDS OF DEERHURST CHURCH
TREASURER'S REPORT as at 31st March 2025

Our position remains strong. A number of new members, including life members, have joined: welcome to all. Book sales continued, and my thanks are due to Garth Reynolds for organising monthly lists of sales.

The overall balance on the 1st of April 2024 (start of financial year) was £44, 283, held at Lloyds Bank (£17,760) and Redwood Bank (£26, 523 which includes over £898 in interest earned for the financial year).

The overall balance on the 31st of March 2025 was £153, 641 held at Lloyds Bank and £27, 511 held at Redwood Bank (including £988 interest). The reasons for this increase in our funds are the generous bequests made to the Friends by the estate of Doreen Farthing (£4, 000) and the estate of Mrs Jean Hollingworth (£133, 205).

Book sales are again recorded as part of our income, as we continue to produce new books arising from our annual Deerhurst lectures, the latest being Trevor Cooper's *The Post-Reformation Communion Furnishings at St Mary's, Deerhurst and their Context*, the printing of which was funded by the generous contribution of £2000 towards the cost of printing.
