Friends of Beaconsfield High Trustees Report 2024-2025

The purpose of the Friends of Beaconsfield High School PTA is to raise funds and strengthen the school community to benefit and advance the education of the students of Beaconsfield High School. All parents of children at the school are automatically members of the PTA, however fundraising events and initiatives are generally run by a small group of volunteers.

The governance of the PTA is managed by the current Chair, Treasurer and Secretary. The Chair and Treasurer are trustees of the charity. There are no paid employees and trustees and volunteers are only reimbursed for direct expenses incurred on behalf of the charity.

Termly PTA meetings are held where plans for the fundraising events and priorities for funding for the school are discussed and agreed. The committee have agreed that minimum reserves of £5,000 should be maintained for any emergency funding required by the school and for event costs in advance.

The year to 31st July 2025 went very well. Total funds raised in the year of £33,697 (2024: £40,848). The 2025 was down £6,881 compared to 2024 primarily due to a decrease in one off donations from £6,156 to £310. Our events included the ever popular Christmas Fair, Quiz Nights and Year 7/8 Disco's plus the ongoing initiatives such as second hand uniform sales and My School Lottery.

Overall, 2025 was a great achievement and allowed a cash donation of to the school £36,245 during the year and an allowance for a donation of £26,000 in 2026 which relates to the 2024-25 activity period (ie an accrual). Funds donated to the school were used primarily to fund a complete refurbishment of the main hall and outside pond area, new interactive whiteboards, a new water fountain and benches for the students to use at break and lunchtime.

All parents of children at the school are automatically members of the PTA, however fundraising events and initiatives are generally run by a small group of volunteers. The governance of the PTA is managed by the current Chair, Treasurer and Secretary. The Chair and Treasurer are trustees of the charity. There are no paid employees and trustees and volunteers are only reimbursed for direct expenses incurred on behalf of the charity. Termly PTA meetings are held where plans for the fundraising events and priorities for funding for the school are discussed and agreed. The committee have agreed that minimum reserves of £5,000 should be maintained for any emergency funding required by the school and for event costs in advance.

The year to 31st July 2024 went very well, with the Christmas Fair being a great success, raising over £14,644. Total funds raised in the year of £40,848 (2023: £35,991) was an immense achievement and allowed the donation of £35,256 to the school.

Other events included the ever popular Quiz Nights and Year 7/8 Disco's plus the ongoing initiatives such as second hand uniform sales and My School Lottery. Due to reducing numbers and requiring a disproportionate amount of administration, the Becky High Hundred's initiative was closed during the year. It is hoped that any active members will redirect donations to the School Lottery.

Funds donated to the school have been spent and are earmarked for a variety of activities, such as outdoor table tennis tables, digital screens and charging banks.

The Chair and Treasurer, having been in post for the maximum term of three years, stepped down at the October 2024 AGM, with the successors being voted in at the same meeting.

Going forward, it is very much hoped to build on the core team of volunteers helping at events. With more parental input considerably more could be achieved!

There are no paid employees and trustees and volunteers are only reimbursed for direct expenses incurred on behalf of the charity. Termly PTA meetings are held where plans for the fundraising events and priorities for funding for the school are discussed and agreed.

The year to 31st July 2023 went very well, with the first Christmas Fair being held since the covid period, which was a great success. A new event was held at the school site, a summer BBQ, providing the opportunity for parents and carers to meet some of the staff team, including the Head Teacher. Total funds raised in the year of £35,991 (2022: £26,908) was an immense achievement and allowed the donation of £25,374 to the school.

Other events included the ever popular Quiz Nights and Year 7/8 Disco's plus the ongoing initiatives such as second hand uniform sales, Becky High Hundreds and My School Lottery.

Funds donated to the school were used for a variety of activities, such as setting up a mindfulness allotment, a contribution to a canopied outside seating area, seating for under the canopy and heaters for outside the canteen area.

Going forward, it is very much hoped to build on the core team of volunteers helping at events. With more parental input considerably more could be achieved!

The purpose of the Friends of Beaconsfield High School PTA is to raise funds and strengthen the school community to benefit and advance the education of the students of Beaconsfield High School. All parents of children at the school are automatically members of the PTA, however fundraising events and initiatives are generally run by a small group of volunteers. The governance of the PTA is managed by the current Chair, Treasurer and Secretary. The Chair and Treasurer are trustees of the charity. There are no paid employees and trustees and volunteers are only reimbursed for direct expenses incurred on behalf of the charity. Half-termly PTA meetings are held where plans for the fundraising events and priorities for funding for the school are discussed and agreed.

The year to 31st July 2022 was still somewhat affected by the impact of covid with a number of events cancelled. However, total funds raised of £26,908 was still an immense achievement and allowed the donation of £14,399 to the school.

Events included the ever popular Quiz Nights and Year 7/8 Disco's plus the ongoing initiatives such as second hand uniform sales, Becky High Hundreds and the Sainsbury's Scheme. A new initiative, My School Lottery, was set up and raised funds of £1,600 in the first year. A Crowdfund also took place in lieu of being able to hold the Christmas Fair, raising £2,400 for the replacement of the hobs in the food tech department.

Funds donated to the school were used for a variety of activities, such as enhancements to the music, PE and drama departments, whiteboards in the classroom and additional outside seating.

Going forward, it is very much hoped to build on the core team of volunteers helping at events. With more parental input considerably more could be achieved! We were also delighted to be able to hold the first Christmas Fair for three years in 2022 following a huge amount of effort by a fantastic team of parent and teacher volunteers.
