Chairman's Report

For the year ended 5 April 2022

The pandemic has seen considerable changes to the way WOC operates, in common with many other charity organisations working in low- and middle-income countries (LMICs). The curtailment of international travel has meant that those of us who have ongoing projects overseas have not been able to visit in person since the start of 2020. As with most clouds, there has been a silver lining, which has seen the growth and development of virtual platforms for distance learning, as well as for clinical case discussions. These have allowed us to keep in touch with the medical staff on the ground, continuing our educational and clinical input.


WOC held its first virtual conference on 5th June 2022, hosted by Orthohub. This has allowed us to reach a wider audience than usual, for which we are very grateful. It was especially heartening to see the interest it generated in trainees, and we are delighted that our trainee subcommittee is going from strength to strength. Several of them have initiated collaboratives with trainees in LMIC countries, which are mutually beneficial.

WOC had a stand at the recent British Orthopaedic Association Congress in Aberdeen on 21st – 24th September, and generated some interest from trainees and a few consultants. We also ran a well-received session on 21st September on Challenges of Managing Orthopaedic Infections in Resource-Poor Settings.

We had a very productive committee meeting on 14th September, and made the decision to hold a face-to-face conference in June 2022.

WOC are also continuing to support a candidate for the BOA Future Leaders Programme for 2022. We had some good quality applications this year, and ended up with a tie, so we are exploring options for funding to see if both candidates can be supported.

Our usual visits have been suspended owing to the travel restrictions, but we hope to resume our travel plans in the coming year.


