YEAR ENDED 05 APRIL 2023

The Trustees present their report and the unaudited financial statements of the Society for the year ended 05 April 2023.

Objectives of the Charity

The principal aims and objectives laid down in the Trust Deed are:

- A) The Proclamation and Furtherance of the Gospel of the Lord Jesus Christ.
- B) To reach out to meet the needs of the people throughout North India in such ways as are charitable according to English Law and in particular to support the Charitable work of North India Outreach Society, a non-profit-making Charitable Body registered in New Delhi, India.

These aims and objectives are being fulfilled by the Charity as detailed below.

Investment powers and restrictions

The Declaration of Trust places no restrictions on the investment powers of the Trustees.

Public Benefit

The Trustees confirm that they have paid due regard to the guidance on public benefit, published by the Charity Commission, in deciding what activities the Charity should undertake.

Review of activities and future developments

During the year, the Society received a very generous legacy of £137,766.

The Society continued to receive small Gift Aid and Other Donations from regular donors. Periodic grants are paid to North India Outreach Society (India) and such payments will be shown on page 4 when made. These payments support education, and ministry of Christian work and promotion of the Christian gospel in North India thus fulfilling the objectives of the Trust Deed. The Trustees are in the process of agreeing the timing of a fresh distribution policy in conjunction with the team in the Society in India

Reserves policy

The Trustees consider that it is prudent to hold funds within their UK bank and to make grants to North India Outreach Society (India) on a periodic basis.
