The potential recipients are not restricted in any other way from a particular section of the public.

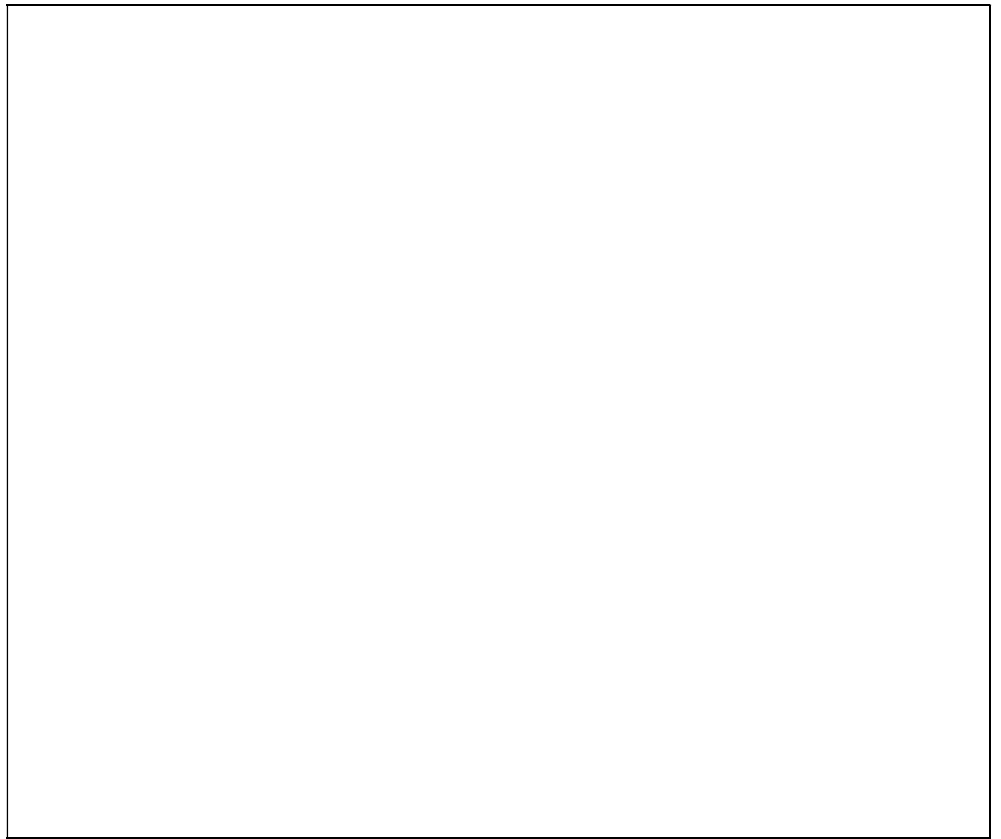

I have no concerns and have come across no other matters in connection with the examination to which attention should be drawn in this report in order to enable a proper understanding of the accounts to be reached.

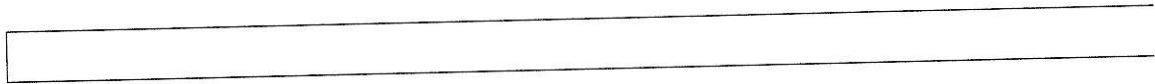
