Other grants from Mylor Parish Council of £7,500 and £3,000 from the Ord Statter Pavilion Trust largely made up our total income of £58,220. We incurred total expenditure of £49,827, giving rise to a surplus for the year of £8,393.



The provision of a pathway alongside Mylor Creek was also provided. Other grants from Mylor Parish Council, £5,100 and the Ord Statter Pavilion Trust £2,000 largely made up our total income of £106,873. We incurred total expenditure of £111,799 giving rise to a deficit for the year of £4,925.
