All funds raised as income through the pool are applied to the expenses incurred either by the contractor or by the council as a form of deficit guarantee.

The trust considers that the major risks associated with these activities are health and safety of its users and it manages this through the activities of the contractor and through the Council's Leisure officers and Safety Adviser.



**Independent Examiner's Report to the Trustees of

I report to the charity trustees on my examination of the accounts of Woodstock and District Swimming Pool (the Charity) for the year ended 31 March 2025 which comprises the receipts and payments account and the statement of assets and liabilities as set out on form CC16a.

Respective Responsibilities of Trustees and Examiner
