CHAIRMAN'S ANNUAL REPORT 2021

In the beginning of 2021, the village hall was still in lockdown due to Covid-19 and only started to open from 21 May. Except for a couple of groups, very few groups used the hall after this date for several months due to the virus still being prominent. However, during the year, more groups gradually returned to use the hall. However, during this time, and for most of the year, the hall still had restrictions imposed on us via laws and strong recommendation.

During the lockdown, some groups decided to leave the AVH and either started using Zoom or in some cases set up their group at home. Due to bad health, the tutor of the Art Group decided to stop using the AVH. As this group at one stage, used the hall three days a week and usually once a month for a Saturday session, this has greatly reduced our income.

Although some groups stopped using the AVH, we did manage to recruit some new groups which brought the number of user groups back to pre-Covid levels. The problems were that the new groups operated at much reduced hours than previous groups that hired the hall before Covid. This was also highlighted by the large reduction of hours due to the loss of the Art Group.

During this year we were supported by grants received from the government to help village halls during the pandemic.

At the beginning of the year, we managed to complete the refurbishment of the old football changing room into a meeting room. We also managed to lay a floor in the loft which was only partially covered before and we removed a lot of old equipment. The main hall floor was also re-skimmed as the previous floor was badly marked and damaged.

In the autumn of 2021, the annual ROSPA inspection took place. It followed the report of 2020 when the ROSPA report was one of the best reports we have had, however it did highlight some equipment that is wearing out and needs to be repaired, for example, the wooden legs are rotting in the wooden swing etc. These need to be addressed over the next two to three years, however the recreation ground and play equipment was still generally in good order.

The village hall still operates the 200 club. The numbers of people who bought shares improved this year. This was mainly due to about three people who bought numerous shares. The 200 club is still popular with people in Atworth. It would help if more people joined the 200 club every year so that the prize money becomes more attractive and it would bring in additional money for the village hall.

Two groups who use the village hall, would normally put on exhibitions in the year. For obvious reasons this could not happen this year.
