The William de Yaxley Church of England Academy has been provided with aid for extra educational facilities of a kind not normally provided by Government (national or local) for the School. In 2024, these included KICK provision of values-based Sports Coaching, Mentoring & Sports Chaplaincy, PiXL membership and the provision of Bibles for the year 6 students when moving on from the school.
