### **Objectives of charity**

The objective of the charity is to raise and manage funds to be used for the benefit of the education of the children at St Peter's School, Tandridge.

During the financial year, the governors of St Peter's have made donations to the school which have enabled the school to employ support staff that are invaluable to the social, emotional as well as academic well-being of the children.
