

THE CHARITY CONTINUES TO GENERATE A HEALTHY INCOME FROM ITS INVESTMENTS AND DONATIONS FROM THE CHARITY'S MEMBERS. THERE WERE A SMALL NUMBER OF FUND RAISING ACTIVITIES AND INCLUDED AN EXHIBITION OF PAINTINGS BY LOCAL ARTIST AND FRIENDS' MEMBER, SUSAN SHAW, WITH PROCEEDS BEING GIVEN TO THE CHARITY.

THE LARGEST SOURCE OF REVENUE WAS FROM REQUESTS AND FUNERAL DONATIONS. IN PARTICULAR A LEGACY WAS RECEIVED FROM A MEMBER WHO DIED DURING THE PERIOD IN THE SUM OF £20,000.
