### Trustees' Annual Report 2024

The Trustees report and financial statements for the year ending 31<sup>st</sup>, December 2024. The Trustees believe that the financial statements comply with the current statutory requirements and the Charity's governing documents.

#### Charity Objectives

The objects of the Church are:

primarily but not exclusively in Fron and the surrounding area;
- 2) such other charitable purposes as shall, in the opinion of the Trustees,




