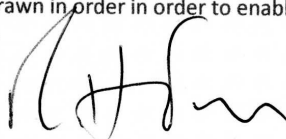
The procedures followed do not provide all the evidence that would be required for a full audit so the report is limited to the matters set out in the statement below.
