Report of the Committee of Management

The objects of the Society are to educate the public in Art and Music by presenting concerts and other activities. The Society is organised by an Executive Committee consisting of the Chair, Secretary, Treasurer and Musical Director along with other elected members.

After the pandemic of the last two years, this has been a much more productive season. We opened last September with a cautious start and many COVID precautions in place. This did not prevent us putting on a rousing performance of Handel's Messiah in December 2021; the audience hunger for a live performance was palpable. A costly, but successful concert which let the community know we were still able to put on a good event. Due to a spike in Coronavirus, the same could not be said of our day of carols a week later – this had to be cancelled due to high levels of infection, both within the choir and our potential audience.

The second half of the season, commencing in January 2022 started well and proceeded, with just one or two slight problems, when both our MD and accompanist fell prey to COVID. Problems overcome, we put on a very successful performance of Rossini's Petite Messe Solennelle with excellent soloists from the Royal College of Music all accompanied by piano and harmonium. To close the season, we held a successful morning workshop, introducing pieces of next season's music. This workshop was open to all, hoping we may have encouraged some new members to join us for the forthcoming season.


We are now looking forward to the coming season. We very much hope to get back to 'normal' and to move forward to the future picking up where we left off in March 2020.

The Society investment Policy is to invest on a cautious basis. This is reviewed periodically by the Executive Committee.

No member of the Executive Committee was paid any remuneration or expenses, the exception being the Musical Director and the Accompanist. No connected persons related or otherwise, to Trustees were employed or remunerated by Grantham Choral Society.


