ACCOUNTANTS REPORT TO THE TRUSTEES FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 JANUARY 2024

Introduction

Prior years' annual income has been below £25,000.

Following receipt of a legacy; the income for the year ended 31 January 2024 exceeded £25,000 but below £500,000.

You have therefore requested an independent examination for the production of the Annual Return for the year ended 31 January 2024.

There is no legal requirement to undertake and make an audit report.

My work is limited to the Receipts and Payments Accounts form CC16a.

Work Undertaken

I have reviewed the information held by the Charity Commission on GOV.UK and obtained the required personal information and checks on the two cheque signatories being Mrs C Morton [Chair] and Mr D C Saunders [Treasurer].

I have examined the transactions in the bank accounts and obtained third party evidence of the legacy.


There has been no requirement to check if expenditure within the authorised activities since the only payments were bank charges.

I have promptly received answers to my enquiries.
