The annual accounts have been prepared in accordance with the accounting policies set out in the notes and comply with the charity's trust deed and applicable law.

The Trustees, the charity's bankers and the objectives and activities are detailed in the annual return to the Charities Commission.

During the year the charity made grants and donations amounting to £21,022 in accordance with the charity's objectives.

The charity operates a single unrestricted fund that is represented by cash balances held in the charity's bank account. The fund was not in deficit at any time during the year and no funds were held as custodian trustees.

#### **Trustees' Responsibilities**

The trustees are responsible for maintaining accounting records and preparing financial statements of the charity under the Charities Act and Statement of Recommended Practice: Accounting and Reporting by Charities (SORP 2005).

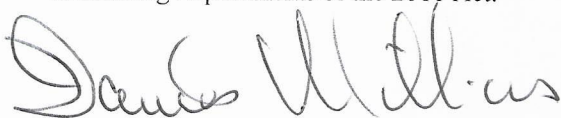

This departure has involved following Accounting and Reporting by Charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) issued on 16 July 2014 rather than the Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice effective from 1 April 2005 which has since been withdrawn.

Your attention is drawn to the fact that the charity has prepared the accounts (financial statements) in accordance with Accounting and Reporting by Charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) in preference to the Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice issued on 1 April 2005 which is referred to in the extant regulations but has been withdrawn.
