The backbone of the Choirs activity during 2024 continued to be regular appearances at concerts arranged for visitors at St John's Church in Llandudno attended by audiences of 500+ each time. This year also included regular appearances to entertain visitors to a holiday complex at Henllys Hall on Anglesey attended by smaller, but similarly enthusiastic audiences.

These events have expanded the number of people benefiting from the activities of the Charity.

They also performed in Bangor Cathedral as part of a charity concert for St David's Hospice, Llandudno.

The choir competed at the local Eisteddfod in Bethesda.

Charitable carol singing was arranged for shoppers at a local Supermarket and for residents at a local Old Peoples Home, and community carol singing at various times over the Christmas period.

To conclude therefore, the Charity seeks to fulfil and further its aims, as set out in Section C above by taking part in regular performances, attended by hundreds of people during the year.
