April 2025

LADIES AND GENTLEMEN, GOOD EVENING AND WELCOME TO THIS ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING OF THE GARFORTH COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION.

DUE TO VARIOUS PROBLEMS OF ILL HEALTH { MAINLY MINE} THE AGM WAS NOT HELD IN JANUARY AS USUAL. MOVING IT TO EARLY APRIL WAS CONSIDERED SOME TIME AGO TO TAKE ADVANTAGE OF THE LIGHTER NIGHTS AND HOPEFULLY BETTER WEATHER. UNLESS THERE ARE MANY OBJECTIONS, I PROPOSE THAT WE CONTINUE WITH THIS ALTHOUGH MAINTAINING THE FINANCIAL YEAR END AT DECEMBER 31<sup>ST</sup>.

AS THE ASSOCIATION WAS FORMED IN SEPTEMBER 1973 THIS SHOULD BE THE 52<sup>ND</sup> AGM.

IT IS MY PLEASURE TO PRESENT TO YOU MY REPORT ON THE ACTIVITIES OF THE ASSOCIATION IN 2024.

FIRST OF ALL, I AM HAPPY TO REPORT THAT THE MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE HAS FULFILLED THEIR MAIN TASK IN ACCORDANCE WITH OUR CONSTITUTION.

BOOKING LEVELS THROUGHOUT 2024 WERE HIGHER THAN BEFORE MAKING THE HALL BUSY AGAIN.

A LOT OF REGULAR BOOKINGS NOW SEEM TO BE FIRM FIXTURES AND HOPEFULLY WILL CONTINUE SO.

HOWEVER, DUE TO THE COVID PANDEMIC WE HAD TO FOREGO THE AGMS OF 2021 AND 2022.

THE CHARITIES COMMISSION REQUIRES THAT WE SUBMIT AN ANNUAL REPORT WITH FINANCIAL RECORDS. I WAS ABLE TO COMPLY FOR 20 AND 21, DESPITE NOT HOLDING THE AGMS.

IT IS NOW MY PLEASURE TO PRESENT TO YOU MY REPORT ON THE ACTIVITIES OF THE ASSOCIATION IN 2022.

FIRST OF ALL, I AM HAPPY TO REPORT THAT THE MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE HAS FULFILLED THEIR MAIN TASK IN ACCORDANCE WITH OUR CONSTITUTION.

DURING THE PANDEMIC WE ALSO RECEIVED VIA LCC A GOVERNEMENT GRANT OF £10 k WHICH HELPED TO ENSURE OUR FINANCIAL SURVIVAL.

THE MAIN CAPITAL EXPENDITURE DURING SHUTDOWN WAS ON A DEFIBRILLATOR WHICH WAS PARTLY FUNDED BY CAROLINE ATHAS DANCE CLASS. WE ALSO HAVE A NEW SECURITY LOCK SYSTEM WHICH COMES WITH PROGRAMMABLE KEYS THAT WE CAN CONTROL MORE EASILY.

INDEED, UNLIKE MANY SIMILAR ORGANISATIONS ACROSS THE COUNTRY WE MANAGED TO ACTUALLY KEEP GOING THROUGHT THE CRISIS ALBEIT WITH A VERY MUCH REDUCED PROGRAMME.

IN PARTICULAR I WOULD TO MENTION AND THANK.--

MICK AINSLEY OUR CARETAKER MADE SURE THE NECESSARY SUPPLIES OF WIPES AND SANITISER WERE KEPT UP AND THAT ALL RELEVANT SIGNAGE WAS IN PLACE TO LIMIT THE SPREAD OF INFECTION. HE ALSO TOOK THE OPPORTUNITY TO CLEAN THE ENTIRE BUILDING AND DO A LOT OF DECORATING.

THE AA, WHOSE MEETINGS WENT ON WHENEVER POSSIBLE.

AND CARLINE ATHA WHOSE PUPILS ATTENDED

THEIR DANCE CLASSES WHENEVER THE LOCKDOWN RULES WERE RELAXED SUFFICIENTLY, SUBJECT TO HER VERY STRICT REGIME FOR BOTH PARENTS AND PUPILS.

I AM HAPPY TO REPORT THAT GRADUALLY OVER 2022 OUR BOOKINGS HAVE RECOVERED AND THE MAJORITY OF OUR REGULAR USERS ARE ON STREAM AGAIN.
