- 3) Previous Minutes: Accepted.
- 4) Fund & Investment update: M&G. £50,578.97.

- 5) Applications: Only one was received and an award of £300.00 agreed.
- 6) Charity Commission form. To be completed and returned.
- 7) Correspondence: There had been one or two queries regarding applications. Whilst late for this meeting, they would be encouraged to apply to the March 2025 meeting of Trustees.
A kind 'thank you ' letter was received from a recent recipient of an award.
- 8) Communication: The Trustees expressed concern at the lack of applications. This could be due in part to the hiatus recently experienced with the banks.
Nevertheless it was felt a reminder in the Parish Magazine (February 2025) would be appropriate for applications being considered at the March 2025 meeting.
It was also suggested that a regular monthly inclusion in the magazine might encourage and remind potential applicants .
