2021-22 End of year report.

It continues to be a challenging and restrictive time due to with Covid and lockdowns. Nevertheless, with Dominic Wilkinson on board as Creative Director we began to develop alternative plans in which we could utilise other exhibition facilities in the city centre without undue cost and long-term commitment.

We did attempt to lease a building in Hope St Liverpool, but this became protracted due to legalities and we finally decided against it in the light of other opportunities with LJMU. Because of Covid and the inability to plan we closed the office space at the Baltic Liverpool reducing our overheads still further. We now have one space at the Baltic which is the archive store.

In discussion with staff at LJMU we agreed a date for next year in which they would curate a large-scale experimental exhibition of Fanchons artwork in their ERL gallery. This would include research funding for students. The publishing of Fanchon book progressed by editing and designing the book. The plan is to publish with Amazon next year.
