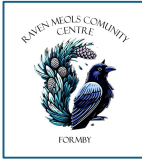

INTRODUCTION

Raven Meols Community Centre was established in November 1985 to address the need for a community space where local groups could meet in a comfortable, warm, and accessible environment. Our mission is to provide an affordable venue for local residents and organizations to meet, hold activities, and foster community spirit.

The centre offers a variety of amenities, including two meeting rooms, a fully equipped kitchen, and large storage areas. Groups also have the option to hire the adjacent Hall of the Professional Development Centre (PDC) for larger events. The Centre is governed by an Executive Committee of volunteers, composed of three Trustees and two Committee Members, all of whom are committed to maintaining a space that supports the community.

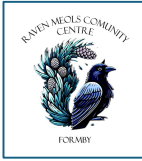

RECENT DEVELOPMENTS

Over the past year, the Executive Committee has focused on improving the facilities to enhance the experience for the groups that use the Centre. Thanks to grants from Formby Parish Council and Sefton LA Transitional Funding, we were able to:

- Re-decorate key areas of the Centre
- Install new carpeting
- Make several general improvements to our facilities

These enhancements have already been positively received by the groups. We anticipate that these improvements will increase usage of the Centre, further benefiting the local community.

FINANCIAL YEAR ENDING 31ST MARCH 2024

Income & Expenses

The Centre's operational costs are primarily covered by the fees charged to the groups that use the facilities. Despite rising costs, particularly due to increased energy prices, our rates remain competitive compared to other local venues.

For the financial year 2024/25, we anticipate:

- Projected Income: £19,000
- Projected Expenditure: £17,000

Our contingency fund remains sufficient to cover unexpected financial events and future costs, such as lease obligations with Sefton County Council and other emergency expenses. We review the Centre's accounts at every Executive Committee meeting, ensuring transparency and careful financial management.

Grants and Funding

While we have successfully secured funding this past year, we remain vigilant regarding future funding opportunities. Should we encounter any shortfalls, we are prepared to make necessary adjustments to ensure the Centre's long-term sustainability.

ACHIEVEMENTS AND CHALLENGES

Achievements

- Successful completion of the renovation and redecoration of the Centre, funded by external grants.
- Maintained a strong and diverse range of groups using our facilities.
- Kept rental fees at affordable rates despite inflationary pressures.

Challenges

- The rising cost of energy has required us to adjust fees to maintain financial stability.
- Securing additional grants remains a key focus to ensure that we can continue to offer a high standard of facilities.

- Further increases in energy prices
- Changes in the availability of grants or external funding
- Decreases in community group participation due to external economic factors

Our contingency plans are in place to address these risks, ensuring that the Centre continues to operate effectively, even under challenging circumstances.
