Para 1.20	Two large grants were successful in 2020-2021. One for £25,000 from The Wooden Spoon Foundation which was granted towards the provision of a new wooden structured play area for the youngest primary aged pupils. The second grant was for £5,000 from the Halsall Foundation which was also bid for to enhance the older pupils' play areas with equipment and resources for outdoor play. These grants have allowed the school to build on existing dilapidated provision enhancing the outdoor play experience for the pupils of all ages. This allows them to build their fine motor skills, boosts their exercise and promotes teamwork and friendships.

This has been successful this year with the building of the new playground and the provision of equipment to enhance the outdoor play and learning experiences. Due to the pandemic the school has not held any residential visits for the pupils but these are planned to be resumed and funded via the charity in future years.
