Bothel village hall committee has the responsibility of maintaining the fabric and structure of the village hall and promoting it as a centre of community life.

This financial year had the continued problems of Covid restrictions which had to be followed at all times for any activities in the hall. Consequently hire of the hall was significantly reduced but our income was helped considerably from Local Authority grants.

As soon as it was considered safe to do so we have promoted and encouraged activities to restart and we have a good range of weekly events.

One of our main achievements has been to establish a community library in our entrance porch. We have been able to leave it unlocked at all times for access to books and jigsaws. It was greatly appreciated during covid restrictions and is a real asset to the village.

We continue to have good community support with an increasing number of volunteers for cleaning and tending the gardens. Our committee has welcomed several new younger members.


