Accounts

Report for accounts ending March 31st 2024

Mr. Richard Bridges audited the accounts provided by former Treasurer, Stella Douglas.

Slaley Commemoration Hall had an opening balance of £35,233.66 at 31/3/2023, and by 31/3/2024 it had a closing balance of £16,769

Solar & Battery Storage

The solar and battery storage became effective during this financial year and power is being exported to the grid. £18,336.50 was the 65% of battery cost in May 23 followed by £6,000 transferred and finally £5,821 in August (final 10% of battery cost and £3,000 for cabinet to store batteries). An area of hardstanding was also constructed for the battery cabinet to stand on safely outside the main building. A grant of £10,665.00 in July from Tees Valley Combine (Northeast & Yorkshire Net Zero Hub) was received towards the solar and battery storage.

Repairs

The building celebrated its 100th birthday in December 2022 unfortunately any 100-year-old building suffers from unexpected repairs. The ridge tiles on both west and east gables began to leak water internally resulting in a £4,200 roofing invoice followed by £600 for internal decoration. Guttering to the south was replaced in September costing £1560. Lightfoot two invoices were £813. A replacement welcome plaque inside the main door recorded the 100-year renovations. Materials for the decking £1290.18 Jackson Timber in March 2024. This increased expenditure in running costs explains the difference between 2023 and 2024.

Income:

A second Christmas Fair in November 2023 with proceeds ring-fenced towards curtains. £600 of this was spent in August 2023 for Community Room window blinds.

Snack and Chat, each fortnight between October and April brought in an additional £430 compared to 2023.

SCH 200 Club had a shortfall of £37 compared to 2023.

£1,000 in August was a grant towards the Decking.

Facilities:

Decking at the rear of the Hall has been completed, thanks to a £1000 Community Chest grant in August 2023 plus several small grants and work undertaken FOC by a community group.

Acoustics remain a problem in both meeting rooms and will need to be address in the coming months.

Hire income:

An increase in bookings using two rooms, resulted in the increase of hire income.

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Treasurer's Report
15th May 2023

Mr Richard Bridges has audited the accounts for Slaley Commemoration Hall and has provided a statement for signature by the Treasurer and Chair.

Overleaf is a summary of the accounts. As with previous years from the 2018/19 onwards comparisons between years are difficult because of the pandemic and the building activity which reduced the available space for hire. The Hall is now at full capacity again with the completion of the Community Room.

It is expected that the installation of solar battery storage will take most of the Grants and Donations monies. The £628 of Film Club is ring fenced for them. A discussion will take place about some of this being donated to the Commemoration Hall. This account will be closed soon. The Film Club has asked the Commemoration Hall to keep separate accounts in Income and expenditure. I have done this.

SCH200 Club brings significant income which helps to offset the difference between income and expenditure, as does very significant fundraising. Whilst the accounts are good at present and bookings are increasing, fundraising will remain, at least in the short term a significant part of the work of trustees. They are to be thanked for their efforts last year.

The income and expenditure account is in good health. £710 of the monies in there are ring fenced for curtains. The contingency fund is closed. There is a COIF fund of £14,800 approximately which brings in some £400/year income and forms the contingency as was agreed at last AGM.

It is expected that fuel costs will rise. This last financial year the SCH paid about £500 more than the previous financial year. The Hall is on a fixed tariff and the trustees must expect bills to rise. Costs are offset by solar electricity exports which have only recently begun, and the Treasurer will report on this when there is more evidence.

Bookings are strong. As with previous years, summer bookings fall significantly before picking up again in September. New weekly bookings by Parents and Toddlers and Life Drawing have added to income. For the first time in my experience there have been days with 4 bookings. Weekends are quiet and this may provide a focus for future marketing activity.

Please do ask any questions and I will try to answer in the meeting and will endeavour to send answers after the meeting if necessary.

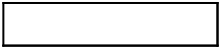

Treasurer's Report 2021.

This report covers the period 1st April 2020 – 31st March 2021 and inevitably looks very different to previous reports as it covers months affected by the pandemic.

The opening balance for the year ending 31st March 2021 was £50,228.35. During that financial year there was a major effort to access grants, donations and fundraising. These raised £65,863.37 which enabled Phase 1 to be completed costing £76,382.28. At the same time income from bookings fell to almost zero. NCC covid-grants brought in £24,237.71. These NCC grants more than covered our regular expenditures – utilities and insurance. Due to these generous grants the closing balance 31st March 2021 was £58,575.15, giving us a surplus of £8,346.80 for that financial year.

Currently we have 5 bank accounts and 1 investment account. Income and Expenditure has £31,059.28. Of this £24,237.71 was from NCC and is currently ring-fenced for running costs. Normal expenditure hovers around £7.5k so this provides a very good buffer for this financial year when bookings will be down.

The Grants and Donations account has £25,496.54. This is ring-fenced for the renovation. There will be a substantial bill to pay on completion of Phase 1 this week. We can expect this fund to be around £21K. SCH200Club has £3,444.66. This too is ring fenced for renovation. The contingency fund has £5,152.69. The policy document on reserves indicates that 10% of income should be placed into this fund each year. Film Club has a ring-fenced £517.30.

The Investment fund which hitherto has not been included in the accounts is a Charity fund set up by trust deed some 60 years ago. This fund value varies with the stock market. The last valuation was £14,312.30. It brings in a £400 dividend most years which usually represents 12.5% of our income.

I would like to thank Richard Bridges who completed both the audit and a significant examination of our accounts this year.

Treasurer's Statement.

I would like to thank Richard Bridges who has not only audited these accounts but has enabled me to modernise the accounting system and provide you with a clear and transparent information.

The two sheets presented today are a snapshot of the accounts. For the financial year 2020-2021 every transaction is available on a spreadsheet. The 2021-2022 accounts are updated at the end of each month and these too are available to you on request. Richard and I will meet quarterly to move the accounts forward after what has been a very different financial year for Slaley Commemoration Hall.

In the spring of 2020, the Virgin Account was closed, and monies transferred to Barclays so that builders invoices could be paid by BACS. Accounts were made available for Film Club, Grants and Donations, Contingency* and the SCH200club. By keeping these items in separate accounts, we were able to provide the transparency which donors required.

Between 2017 and March 2020 the Hall ran much as usual with rental income and utilities expenditure along with fundraising for the renovation. By March 2020 enough funds were secured to begin building work. From March 2020 income was hit by the pandemic closures but was more than offset by grants for running costs. Building began and bills for this were paid. The rather extraordinary numbers for income and expenditure reflect the culmination of that project. The high gift aid income reflects the hard work done by committee members to access grants and donations. Dividends, wages, utilities, insurance etc remained similar to the previous year. The renewals and repairs increase represented a covid- response: items which enabled the Hall to call itself a covid-secure venue.

In past years the SCH has made a loss of between £2000 and £3000. This has been offset by fundraising. This current year is different. The covid grant of £24,237.71 has boosted our funds but these are at present restricted to running costs. It does mean that for some time our fundraising can be targeted solely at Phase 2 if we so choose.

What next? Our Total Current Assets statement is incorrect. The Charity (COIF) Fund and the value of the Commemoration Hall and its contents should be in the accounts. I will create this statement as soon as possible. **We need a new Reserves Policy; ACRE has a policy statement on this which I commend to the AGM. We need a budget.** During Covid we have moved away from cash income being used to cover miscellaneous un-invoiced transactions and this should remain the case. We use internet banking so we have immediate access to our funding situation.
