Trustee's Report for Year ending 31 December 2021

- 1 The Charity is known as "The Nantwich and Acton Grammar School Foundation" ("the charity"). The charity was entered on the Register of Charities on 21st May 1963, its registered number being 525965.
- 2 The charity is governed by a scheme of the Charity Commissioners dated 26th July 1995 ("the scheme"). It is administered by a body of seven trustees: one - ex-officio, the Headteacher of Malbank School at Nantwich for the time being, three Nominated Trustees, one appointed by Cheshire East Council, one appointed by Nantwich Town Council and one appointed by the Governors of Malbank School. Nominated Trustees are appointed for a period of four years.
- 3 Co-opted Trustees shall be persons who through residence, or occupation or employment, or otherwise, have special knowledge of the area of benefit. Every Co-opted Trustees shall be appointed for a term of five years by a resolution of the Trustees.
- 4 The principal office of the charity is the Clerk to the Trustees office at Malbank School and Sixth Form College, Welsh Row, Nantwich, Cheshire, CW5 5HD.
- 5 The area of benefit is determined as the catchment area of the former Nantwich & Action Grammar School. Subject to the payment of expenses the Trustees shall apply the income of the charity:-
 - (a) In or towards providing such special benefits of any kind not normally provided by the local education authority at the Malbank County High School and
 - (b) In otherwise promoting the education (including social and physical training) of persons under 25 years of age who are pupils or former pupils of Malbank School, or any other school serving the area of benefit.
- 6 The financial position of the charity is considered satisfactory at present.

Independent Examiner's Report to the Trustees' of Nantwich and Acton Grammar School Foundation

I report on the accounts of the Trust for the year ended 31 December 2021 which are set out on pages 5 to 7.

1 Basis of Preparation of Accounts

3 Income

Investment income is accounted for as received by the charity.

4 Value Added Tax

5 Management and Administration Expenditure

Expenditure on management and administration includes all expenditure incurred by the charity not directly related to grants and awards.
