



INDEPENDENT EXAMINER'S REPORT TO THE TRUSTEES OF THE CARDINAL GLEMP FOUNDATION

I report on the accounts of the Foundation for the year ended 31 December 2021, which are set out on page 5.


Basis of Independent Examiner's report

The Independent examination was carried out in accordance with general Directions given by the Charity Commission. An examination includes a review of the accounting records kept by the charity and a comparison of the accounts presented with those records. It also includes consideration of any unusual items or disclosures in the accounts and seeking explanations from the trustees concerning any such matters.
