The Trustees have had regard to the Public Benefit guidance issued by the Charity Commission for Northern Ireland.

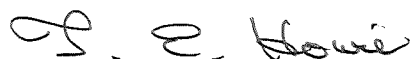
Trustees' Report for the year ended 31st March 2025 (cont'd)
